

TITLE 329 SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT DIVISION

Rule Information Sheet

Transfer Station Reporting
LSA Document #19-424

Overview

This rulemaking amends the reporting requirements for solid waste transfer stations at 329 IAC 11-13.5-1, 329 IAC 11-13.5-13, and 329 IAC 11-13.5-17. The purpose of this rule is to remove the annual reporting requirement in 329 IAC 11-13.5-17 and move the remaining record keeping requirements to 329 IAC 11-13.5-13. The transfer station annual report would no longer need to be submitted to IDEM because IDEM staff can view these records during on-site facility visits. Moving the requirements for the record keeping to 329 IAC 11-13.5-13 makes 329 IAC 11-13.5-17 obsolete, so IDEM is proposing to repeal 329 IAC 11-13.5-17. This rulemaking will also update the biosolids and septage acceptance requirements at 329 IAC 11-13.5-13(b)(11) and 329 IAC 11-13.5-13(b)(12) for clarification. In accordance with a statutory change to IC 13-18-12, the term "wastewater" is being replaced with "septage." Transfer stations currently check incoming solid waste including all the items listed in 329 IAC 11-13.5-13(a).

Affected Persons

Solid waste transfer stations are the parties affected by this rulemaking.

Reasons for the Rule

The amendments to 329 IAC 11-13.5-1 and 329 IAC 11-13.5-13 and repeal of 329 IAC 11-13.5-17 will streamline reporting requirements by eliminating the requirement for transfer stations to submit an annual report to IDEM. The required information will be available to IDEM staff at the transfer station.

Economic Impact of the Rule

There will be a positive fiscal impact from the implementation of this rule because it eliminates unnecessary reporting by transfer stations.
