## Rule Information Sheet

Marion County Sulfur Dioxide Redesignation and City of Muncie Lead Redesignation  
LSA Document #20-473

### Overview

This rulemaking amends the attainment status tables for certain air pollutants in Delaware and Marion Counties. The proposed amendment revises the attainment designation for a portion of the City of Muncie under the 2008 annual primary and secondary National Ambient Air Quality Standards (NAAQS) for lead at 326 IAC 1-4-19 and the attainment designation for Perry, Wayne, and Center townships in Marion County under the 2010 1-hour primary NAAQS for sulfur dioxide at 326 IAC 1-4-50. These changes are necessary to align the Indiana Administrative Code with new federal designations that were published by the United States Environmental Protection Agency in the *Federal Register* on May 15, 2020 and May 21, 2020.

### Affected Persons

The attainment redesignation for the portion of the City of Muncie could potentially impact any new or existing sources that emit lead and are subject to major source permitting requirements. The attainment redesignation of Perry, Wayne, and Center townships in Marion County could potentially impact any new or existing sources that emit sulfur dioxide and are subject to major source permitting requirements.

### Reasons for the Rule

This rule is in response to final rules published by U.S. EPA in the *Federal Register* on May 15, 2020, and May 21, 2020. These final rules redesignated Center, Perry, and Wayne townships in Marion County from “nonattainment” to “attainment” for the 2010 1-hour primary NAAQS for sulfur dioxide and redesignated the area bounded by West 26<sup>th</sup> Street/Hines Road to the north, Cowan Road to the east, West Fuson Road to the south, and to the west by a line running south from the eastern edge of Victory Temple’s driveway to South Hoyt Avenue and then along South Hoyt Avenue in Delaware County from “nonattainment” to “attainment” for the 2008 annual primary and secondary NAAQS for lead.

### Economic Impact of the Rule

This rule has no economic impact.
