- We are evaluating and developing an ROI for switching from high efficiency florescent lighting to LED fixtures. In 2015 we launched a pilot program to test life cycle and lumen quality of commercially available units. 258 lamps were installed in our main office area and we have plans to expand this test to every area except the production and warehouse areas this year. Each lamp is expected to half the energy consumption of a standard bulb, while more than tripling the life cycle thereby reducing our impact on land fill. However this is still a work in progress and should be a go project in 2016 providing the return is there.
 - Developed new chain former that is very quiet, as older machines are replaced, this will affect the overall plant volume.
 - Land fill continued to decline, and we are at the current foreseeable bottom of where we can get without new packaging initiatives and re-use programs. We continue to work at this.
 - All of our landfill refuse is burnt to fuel the Fort Wayne GM plants co-gen, effectively making us a 0 waste generator.
 - Over the last several years we have increasingly colder winters, and consequently we have failed to hit our reduction goals. Our monitoring of gas consumption did lead us to partner to tune our plant heating to a more efficient temperature profile beginning in November and continuing through the end of January 2015. We believe that this change made to the rapid unit discharge air temperature down from 68° to 62°. This change should show up in our 2015 data.




