

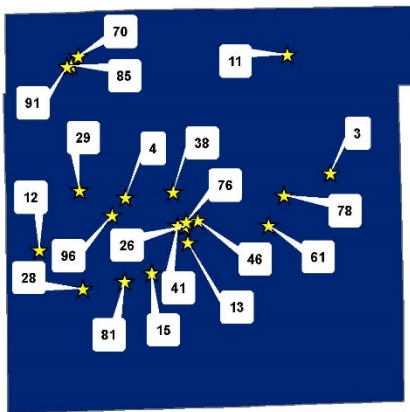

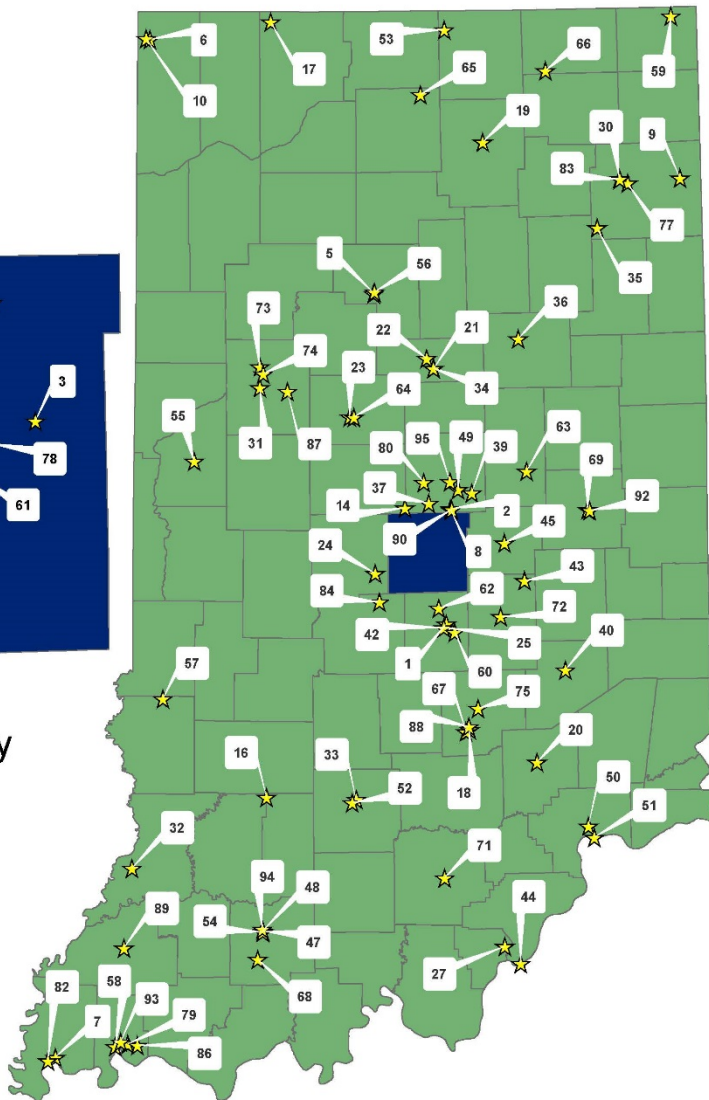
Membership
