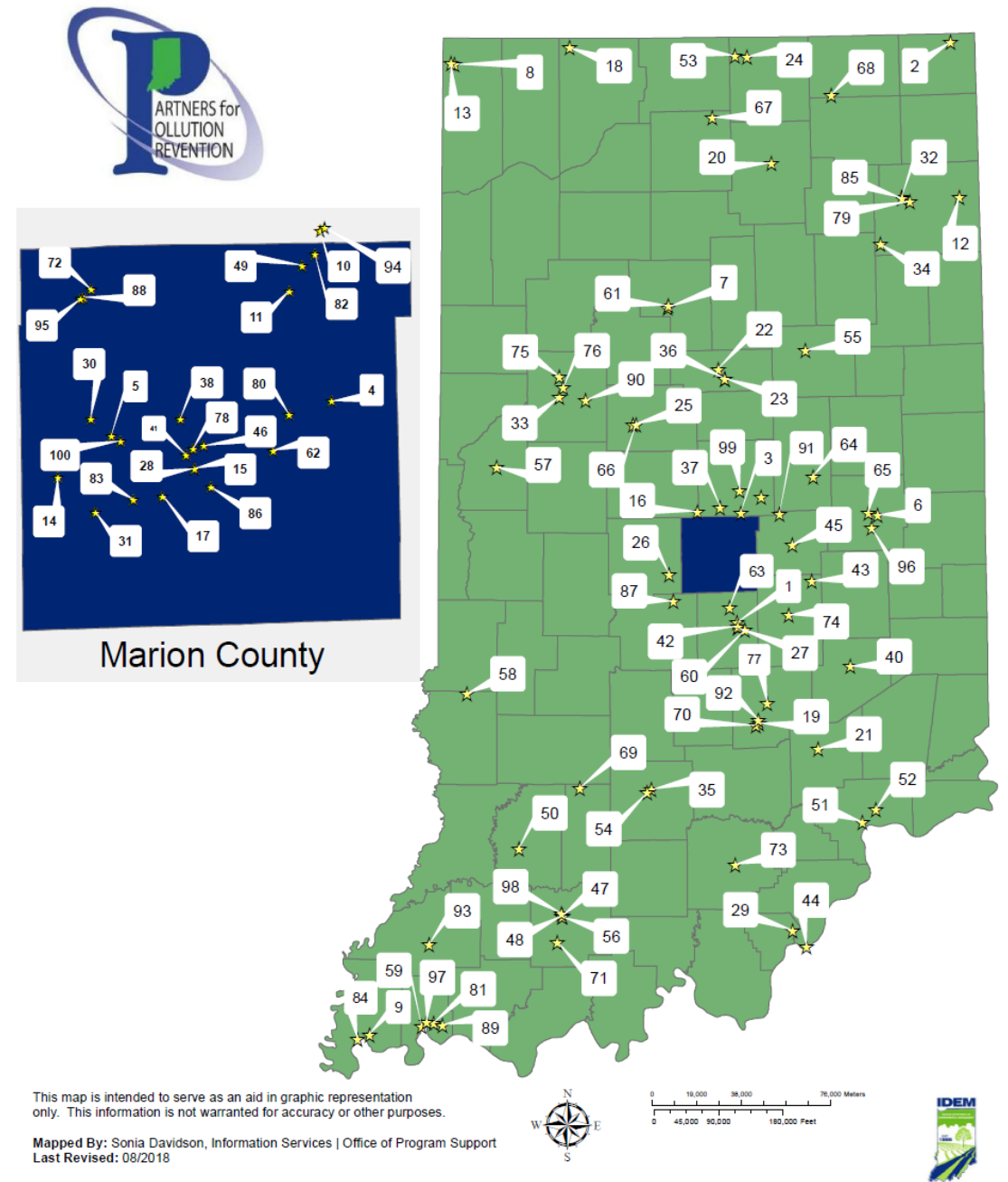
Membership
