



Postal Rate Increase Information

- Effective May 29, 2015, the USPS will implement increased postage rates
- The price of a First-Class meter stamp will increase from \$0.48 to \$0.485 cents per piece
- First-Class flat mail will not increase but remain at \$0.98 cents per piece
- The price of a post card will increase from \$0.34 to \$0.35
- Novitex guarantees the current 3-digit rate for automation compatible mail (see sample rate chart below)
- What's the biggest impact you can make? Eliminate the flat envelope! Folding your letters and using a #10 or a 6x9 envelope can save a minimum of \$.48 per piece! **“You’ve got to know when to fold ‘em!”**
