Amendment # 1

This is an Amendment to the State of Indiana QPA 10131 entered into by and between Indiana Department of Administration on behalf of all state agencies (hereinafter referred to as "State") and Evansville Assc. For the Blind (hereinafter referred to as "Contractor") dated 01/25/2007. In consideration of the mutual undertakings and covenants hereinafter set forth, the parties agree to amend the existing contract as follows:

The following changes shall be made:

Line Item 1, unit of measure shall change from each to dozen at \$52.50 a dozen.

Line Item 2 shall now include a comment stating a case contains 6 items each at a price of \$97.50 a case, minimum order 1 case.

Line Item 3 shall now include the comment stating a case contains 6 items each, minimum order 1 case.

Line Item 4 shall now include the comment stating a case contains 6 items each, minimum order 1 case.

Line Item 5 shall now include the comment stating a case consists of 6 gallons, minimum order 1 case.

Line Items 6, 7, and 8 shall be removed as they are duplications of lines 2-4.

Line Item 9, unit of measure shall be changed from each to dozen at \$33.00 per dozen, minimum order 1 dozen. #730

Total amount of this action is \$0.00. Total remuneration of this contract is not to exceed \$0.00.

All other matters previously agreed to and set forth in the original agreement and not affected by this Amendment shall remain in full force and effect.
