

Amendment # 3

This is an Amendment to the Quantity Purchase Agreement # 10133 for fish feed entered into by and between IDOA/on behalf of all State Agencies (hereinafter referred to as "State") and Zeigler Bros (hereinafter referred to as "Contractor") dated 2/26/2007. In consideration of the mutual undertakings and covenants hereinafter set forth, the parties agree to amend the existing contract as follows:

Feed, Fish Pellet	\$0.503	\$0.542	7%

All other matters previously agreed to and set forth in the original agreement and not affected by this Amendment shall remain in full force and effect.
