1	Can we obtain hauled tonnage data for the industrial containers?	A response is forthcoming and will be posted on the IDOA Solicitation website with the other Bid documents.

3	Regarding the Minimum Requirements spreadsheet, is there a separate spreadsheet you would like completed for pricing to purchase the dumpsters outright?	This requirement has been removed.
4	Regarding outright purchase of dumpsters, pricing can be provided for comapctors. Pricing will not be provided for Open tops or Front Load containers. Will a partical bid for purchasing containers be accepted?	This requirement has been removed.
5	Regarding the Minimum Requirements spreadsheet, Statement "The Agency will provide contract with at least four (4) hours notice of pickup requirepemtns." The comapctor hauls must be completed early in the morning do to prision counts. Is it expected to receive same day service with a 4 hour turn around from the time of request to the time the driver arrives at the facility?	This requirement has been updated.
6	What are the business hours that a driver will have access to the containers at each facility?	Hours of access vary by facility.  The Indiana Department of Correction is collecting this data.  Business hours will be posted in an updated Bid List document with each facility soon.
7	Will a document outlining alternatives to the Minimum Requirements Spreadsheet be accepted?	Respondents should provide all information pertainint to the Minimum Requirements in the "Comments/Exceptions to Requirements" column on the Minimum Requirements tab of the Bid List document.

8	A flat monthly rate cannot be quoted for comapctors. Regarding the comapctor service, will you allow service to be quoted as a haul rate including "X" Tons and a per ton rate for any tonnage over "X" tons?	The Bid List has been updated to include a Haul Rate (up to 5000 tons) to all lines and a Rate per Ton (for weights in excess of 5000 tons) for compators.
9	Regarding Minimum Tonnage Requirements Spreadsheet, Front Load and Residental Toters cannot be weighed. Will weights on only the roll off services be accepted?	This requirement has been updated.
10	Will a "No Bid" on a service line be accepted as a bid on all line items for the the bid to still be considred valid?	Respondents can list "No Bid" on a Facility that they do not wish to service. However, for a Respondent to be considered responsive for a facility, they much provide pricing for each line under that Facility. Partial responses for a Facility will not be accepted.
