

Cost Proposal Narrative

It is the intent of Deaf Community Services to honor the pricing schedule established by the Indiana Deaf and Hard of Hearing Services (DHHS) for American Sign Language interpreting and CART services. The following is a list of the current hourly rates set forth by DHHS:

Hourly State rates paid for Interpreter and CART certification level:

- a. Non-IIC interpreters (only used with pre-approval from DHHS's Director) - \$18.00
- b. IIC - Provisional - \$30.00
- c. IIC - Grandfathered - \$35.00
- d. Nationally Certified with RID or any other nationally recognized certification organization for 10 years or less - \$45.00
- e. Nationally Certified with RID or any other nationally recognized certification organization for more than 10 years and less than 15 years - \$50.00
- f. Nationally Certified with RID or any other nationally recognized certification organization for more than 15 years - \$55.00
- g. Video Remote Interpreting - \$1.00/minute with a minimum of 30 minutes paid per job.
- h. Non-Certified CART (only used with pre-approval from DHHS) - \$40.00
- i. CART (Court Reporting School Certificate) or 180 wpm literary, 225 wpm Q and A or Speech to Text - \$55.00
- j. CART (NCRA CRR – Certified Real-time Reporter or CCP – Certified CART Provider)/National Speech to Text - \$90.00
- k. Mileage - \$0.39 per mile, or the current state rate
