

Cost Assumptions, Conditions and Constraints

The following is a list of assumptions:

Item # 70: Interpretation In-Person ASL, IIC

Deaf Community Services assumes that this rate is an old rate that was used prior to the pricing schedule set forth by DHHS. As such, the new rate breakdown for different IIC levels would replace this rate. Rather than one generic IIC rate, Deaf Community Services would apply the correct IIC rate that corresponds to the interpreter's IIC level.

Item # 74: After hours In-Person Interpretative Services, ASL, IIC

Deaf Community Services assumes that this rate is an old rate that was used prior to the pricing schedule set for the by DHHS. As such, Deaf Community Services would not issue a separate, increased rate for after hours ASL interpreting services.

Item # 79: Audio Description and Captioning

Deaf Community Services assumes that this rate is minimally used, since it only accounts for one hour in the overall cost proposal. As such, this rate has not been established by DHHS; and therefore, Deaf Community Services would apply our standard rate for these services. However, it is assumed that if DHHS were to establish such a rate in the future, we would honor that rate.
