Role of Guiding Team

- Attend two meetings per year
- Provide guidance to establish strategic direction of the OST Advisory Board
- Drive and encourage engagement of key community leaders
- Align and secure resources to support initiative planning and implementation
- Ensure accountability of planning team and work groups to support the initiative
- Provide influence to support systems and policy change

Role of OST Advisory Board Members

- Attend quarterly meetings
- Support the identification and procurement of resources to support initiative planning and implementation
- Facilitate engagement opportunities and activities with key stakeholders
- Support communications with engaged leaders and community partners
- Ensure data collection and reporting procedures are established and implemented
- Engage stakeholders in work groups and support work group activities (as appropriate and needed)
- Serve on Work Groups

Role of Work Groups

- Meet monthly (or as needed) to implement designated initiative strategies and activities
- Work group chairs also assigned to guiding team
- Tasked with operationalizing the vision identified
- Coordinate partner engagement and ensure alignment of initiative activities

Role of OST Funders Network

- Meet two times per year
- Engage and inform the funding community regarding OST
- Align funder priorities to ensure resources are targeted in meaningful and relevant ways
- Coordinate investments to maximize the collective impact
