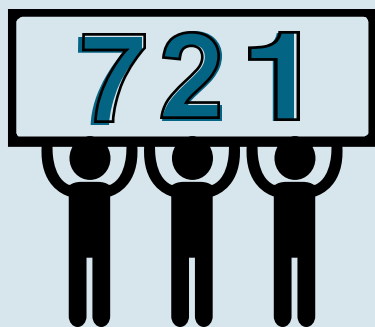

41%

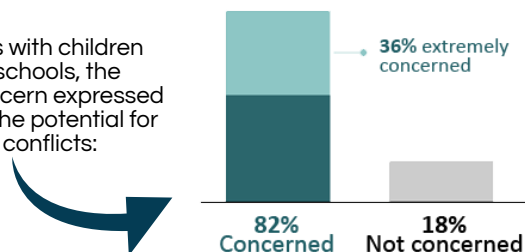
**of parents desire to resume all in-person learning, assuming appropriate safety measures are in place.**

- 35% of parents desire a mix of in person and distance learning
- 23% of parents desire distance learning

If dissatisfied with the method of return their child's school chooses, parents indicated they...

- 7%** will look for another school for my child to attend
- 14%** will ask their school to reconsider their decision
- 58%** will see request accommodations to fit my child's needs
- 15%** will homeschool

For parents with children in multiple schools, the level of concern expressed regarding the potential for scheduling conflicts:

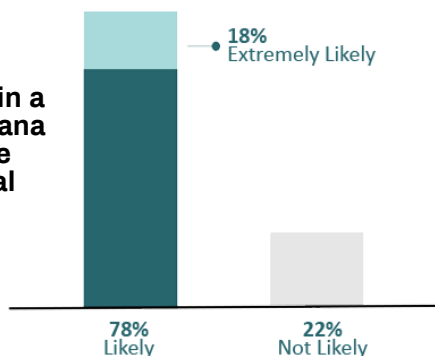

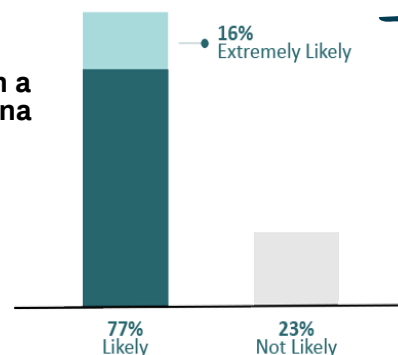

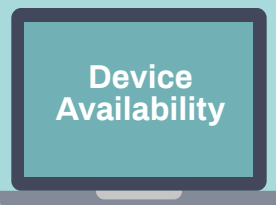
Likelihood someone in a child's household/ohana will be able to provide learning/technological support in the fall:

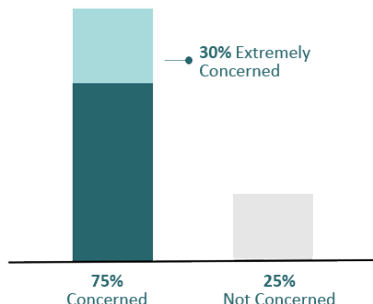
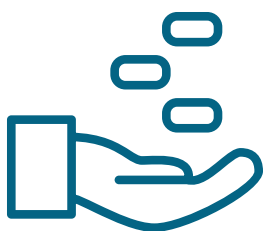

## Previous Afterschool & Child Care Support
