InteCare provides transformative solutions for communities and health care systems with a goal to assist in enhancing delivery of care, increase access to basic services, and build a more equitable community. Intecare's office is in Marion County and is committed to serving Marion County and surrounding counties. In the past few decades, there's been major growth in the health and human services field towards the goal of improved coordination of care and better outcomes.

InteCare has received a Three-Year CARF accreditation in Rapid Rehousing and Homeless Prevention for our Supportive Services for Veteran Families (SSVF) program. This is the highest level of accreditation awarded by CARF and demonstrates InteCare's commitment to excellence and conformance with the CARF standards. An organization receiving a Three-Year Accreditation has put itself through a rigorous peer review process and has demonstrated to a team of surveyors during an on-site visit that its programs and services are of the highest quality, measurable, and accountable.

In 2013, InteCare was awarded a Supportive Services for Veteran Families grant from the department of Veteran Affairs and has since served over 4,000 families and counting. InteCare is dedicated to serving Veterans through their SSVF program and partnered with A&C from 2013-2016 as a service provider under the SSVF program. In 2020 Adult and Child Health became a service partner, this time focusing services and resources in Marion County and surrounding counties. The purpose of the SSVF program is to promote housing stability among low-income Veteran families who reside in or are transitioning to permanent housing. This aligns well with the A&C Mission "With hope, compassion and creativity, Adult & Child delivers life-enhancing physical, social and behavioral health care services". InteCare's SSVF program operates in Boone, Clay, Hamilton, Hancock, Johnson, Madison, Marion, Parke, Shelby, Sullivan, Vermillion, and Vigo Counties. The services provided related to housing stability include outreach, case management, assistance obtaining VA and other public benefits, housing counseling and assistance, financial planning as it relates to stabilizing housing, transportation, childcare, and temporary financial assistance as it relates to stabilizing housing.
