We have recently opened a brand-new emergency room and outpatient services facility and have taken the exciting step of breaking ground on a brand-new behavioral health unit. We recognize the need for increased mental health services in our county and are excited to become a partner in the solution for mental health care in IN. We promote and support collaborative efforts to create and sustain more effective interactions among mental health care providers, individuals with mental illnesses and addiction, their families, and communities, to reduce stigma. As a healthcare system working towards systematic change in Johnson County, we understand the need for mental health reform and innovative services to improve the mental health of those in our community.

Johnson Memorial Health has directly benefited from A&C's CCBHC grantee status. For the last two years, A&C's mobile crisis team has been responding to our emergency room, providing biopsychosocial assessments and recommendations for our ER medical team, allowing us to create a detailed and quick connection to behavioral health services post ER visit. Since the inception of the CCBHC grant and mobile crisis team, A&C has provided 231 assessments in our emergency room, providing 693 post ER visit follow-up engagement calls with JMH patients. A&C has also followed up with all patients post inpatient psychiatric admissions to ensure continuity of care occurs between facilities. A&C has historically been a partner in our primary care clinics, embedding a community health worker to continue ensuring our patients have the appropriate connection to much needed behavioral health services. Johnson Memorial Health continues to grow our behavioral health expertise and appreciates the partnership that A&C has provided in this journey.
