The Division of Mental Health and Addiction has issued a Community Mental Health Center Certification to Southwestern Behavioral Healthcare, Inc. The Division issues only one printed certification per certified provider. To maintain certification as a Community Mental Health Center, the agency must maintain accreditation from an accrediting agency approved by the Division. Any changes in accreditation status must be reported to the Division. Certification expires ninety (90) days after the expiration of the agency's accreditation.

Critical Incident Reporting

Residential Living Programs and outpatient programs are required to report critical incidences. Details on what is required to report can be found in rule, 440 IAC 7.5-2-4 (c) and in contract. Reports of incidences should be made to the DMHA Critical Incident Reporting website, https://dmha.fssa.in.gov/dmha_mir/.

Certification rules include standards for written notification of changes to the Division. Required notice of changes, including changes in operational sites of the services provided, should be submitted in writing to Certification and Licensure Department.
