Person(s) Living in Current Home: Harry Potter is an 8 year old single Caucasian male currently in the 3 rd grade. He currently lives with his aunt-Petunia, uncle-Vernon and cousin-Dudley.

Presenting Problem: Harry is reported to have threatened his cousin with a weapon, stating, "I will get you".	
Previous Psych Tx/Hx (including success of tx): Harry stated that he has wanted therapy in therapy in the past but his reported uncle and aunt told him, "You are not worth it".	
Current Suicidal Ideations/Hx of SI: Harry stated that he is not thinking about hurting himself or anyone else. He stated that he was "just mad and starving" because he was locked in his room over the weekend without out food. He reported that his cousin unlocked his bedroom door while holding a large plate of food and taunted him with it.	
Medical History: Harry has a scar on his forehead from the incident which killed his parents. He reported the scar tends to hurt when he feels a lot of stress	
Allergies: None reported	
Current Medication: Harry reported he has asked his uncle for medication to help him sleep and not feel so sad; his uncle is reported to have refused	
Chemical Dependency (including last use, first use, duration, pattern of use, and consequences): None reported	
Legal History (include relatedness to presenting issue): Harry's uncle Vernon is threatening to press charges against Harry for threatening his son.	
Assessment: Harry Potter is an 8 year old single Caucasian male currently in the 3 rd grade. He currently lives with his aunt-Petunia, uncle-Vernon and cousin-Dudley. His parents have reportedly been deceased since he was a toddler. He presented to this assessment wearing clothes which were much too big for him and which were grayed and faded. He appeared as younger than his stated age, with a slight, malnourished appearance. Harry demonstrated polite behavior, a calm affect, making frequent eye contact. Harry was oriented to person, time, place and event. He was calm and spoke quietly. Harry reported that he had been locked in his room all weekend (Thursday afternoon - Sunday evening) after he and his cousin engaged in a verbal altercation. He reported that, even though his cousin instigated the argument, he is the one who was in trouble. He reported that he had been in his room on restriction for three days when his cousin came in taunting him with a plate of food. He reported his attempt to talk his cousin into giving him some. When the cousin would not, Harry stated he picked up his pencil and held it like a knife and stated, "I will get some of that food". He denied stating "I will get you". Harry denied any thoughts or plans to hurt his cousin. Provider offered Harry granola bars and water, which he accepted politely. Provider reviewed with Harry use of "I" statements to assist him to express his thoughts and feelings.	
Disposition: Staffed with Poppy Pomfrey, NP, who agreed to a safety plan. Provider staffed the need to make a CPS call due to the neglect of being locked in his room for several days without food. NP agreed. Harry was released to his caregivers.
