ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF

Task Force on Education for the Handicapped, Inc.

The undersigned incorporator or incorporators, desiring to form a corporation (hereinafter referred to as the "Corporation") pursuant to the provisions of the Indiana Not-For-Profit Corporation Act of 1971, (hereinafter referred to as the "Act"), executed the following Articles of Incorporation.

ARTICLE I

Name

The name of the Corporation is Task Force on Education for the Handicapped, Inc.
(The name shall include the word "Corporation" or "Incorporated", or one of the abbreviations thereof.)
(hereinafter referred to as the "Task Force")

ARTICLE II

Purposes

The purposes for which the Corporation is formed are:

The Task Force on Education for the Handicapped, Inc. aims to develop a better understanding by the public of the problems of educating the handicapped, and to cooperate with all public, private and religious agencies, whether federal, state, or local and with departments of education and health, and with residential institutions; to gather information on education for the handicapped in the South Bend area; to disseminate, by means of written reports, information on the education services for the handicapped in the South Bend area, and to further the implementation of legislation to facilitate education for the handicapped. (The South Bend area, for the purposes of this organization, is taken to mean St. Joseph County, Indiana.)
