

2026 RFQ: Indiana Multi-unit Addresses

Requirements and Bid Information



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Overview

The Indiana Geographic Information Office has been collecting key framework geographic datasets from all of Indiana's 92 counties regularly for 18 years through its Indiana Data Harvest program (<https://dataharvest.gio.in.gov/>). While dedicated efforts at the local level to increase data quality and Next Generation 911 readiness have yielded significant improvements across the State, one area where enhanced data information would further improve data accuracy and completeness is **multi-unit addresses provided by a third party to check the completeness and accuracy of the multi-unit addresses we receive from local addressing authorities**. *Note that our office, and local government authorities, will use these data to do the actual completeness and accuracy check.*

This RFQ document outlines the requirements of the State of Indiana for this request and information about how the State of Indiana will score the bids it receives. It also lists organizations that are known to our office to have the capabilities to produce the requested data.

Requirements

We require all multi-unit addresses (e.g., those with a letter, fraction, decimal, suite, unit) for all counties in the State of Indiana. Each address **MUST** include:

- Address (includes Unit designation)
- City
- State
- ZIP (5 digit ZIP code)
- ZIP+4 (9 digit ZIP code or 4 digit ZIP code extension)
- Latitude
- Longitude

Match Level Code (indicates the spatial accuracy of the coordinates)

Addresses MUST be current as of September 1st, 2026 (no earlier).

Delivery MUST be made by October 30th, 2026.

Multi-unit addresses for ALL of the following Indiana counties (all 92 counties) are required:

All bids must also answer respond to the following prompts regarding the multi-unit address data and the bid responder's organization:

1. Describe the original source of the multi-unit address data in detail (collection methods, database source, etc.) and describe data verification process.
2. Describe the multi-unit address data update cycle (e.g., bi-weekly, annually, real-time) and update methods (e.g., phone surveys, in-person visits, database purchases).
3. Describe the details of the licensing model that the bid responder proposes to meet the requirement "all addresses MUST be shareable for use by all levels of government in the State of Indiana."
4. Describe the bid responder's organization's experience with address data, statewide (or broader) dataset updates, and supplying data to State Agencies (in Indiana or elsewhere).
