1 The Problem

At work locations where serious incidents can result in injuries such as bleeding, stoppage of breathing, cardiac arrest, etc., access to treatment should be within 3 to 4 minutes from the place of business. For many businesses, however, this is not possible due to their remote nature or location. Proximity and availability to first aid, AEDs and bloodborne pathogen solutions is key to helping prevent further harm to the victim or others responding to an incident. - Employee safety

- Eyewashes/showers help save employee eyesight and prevent chemical burns


