Bids will be received by the Indiana Finance Authority Attn: Brian Renner, 302 West Washington Street, Room E024, Indianapolis, Indiana 46204, from certified contractors holding a valid Certificate of Qualification with the Certification Board, in accordance with I.C. 4-13.6-4, until **1:31 pm** (local time), on **October 17th, 2023**. All bids will be publicly opened and read aloud in a virtual meeting which all bidders will be invited. The Commission reserves the right to reject any and all bids.

1. *Bids must be pdf of complete bid package documents and all required documents. PDF's must be secured so that adjustments cannot be made.*
2. *Email subject must contain "Bid for (project number & name) – due (date & time)"*
3. *Bids can only be sent to the IDOA Deputy Commissioner, Brian Renner at brenner@idoa.in.gov, no cc to anyone or bid may be rejected.*
4. *The IDOA Deputy Commissioner will hold all bid submissions as unread until after bid time has passed. Following verification of Certification we will hold public opening via Teams®.*

The work scope consists of replacing the Food Service building steam system in the mechanical room including steam/condensate and domestic water piping, gas vents, boiler feedwater heater, softeners and chemical mixing station. IN addition, the domestic hot water heaters will be replaced. The construction work includes all equipment, lifting, piping, insulation, and electrical work to provide a complete and operable system.

Bids shall be accepted only from bidders who hold a valid Certificate of Qualification* from the State Certification Board, Public Works Division, Department of Administration, according to I.C. 4-13.6 for the following classifications:

- 1711.01 Plumbing**
- 1711.02 Heating, Ventilating and Air Conditioning**

A virtual pre-bid conference is scheduled for **10:00 AM**, on **October 5th, 2023**. The meeting will be scheduled on Teams®. Applied Engineering will conduct the pre-bid conference on site.

The contractors are **highly encouraged** to visit the site before supplying a bid. The work area is located inside the correctional facility security fence. Coordinate site visits through the Physical Plant Director. Contact information is below. A security may be required to gain access. Be prepared to supply the following information for the individual visiting the site.

Bidding documents will be distributed by Applied Engineering Service, Inc. 5975 Castle Creek Pkwy N Dr, Suite 300, Indianapolis, IN. 46250, the office of the Designer on **September 21st, 2023**. An electronic copy of the bid documents will be provided to prime contractors free of charge. A deposit of \$100.00 will be required for a paper set of documents. There is a limit of 2 complete sets per prime bidder. Upon return of documents the deposit will be refunded if the documents are returned within thirty (30) days of bid opening.

The Indiana Finance Authority, in its commitment to minority business development and the mandate of the Governor's Commission of Minority Business Development (I.C. 4-13-16.5), adopts procedures for this project to assure participation of minority owned business enterprises in all appropriate phases of construction of this project. In accordance with 25 IAC 5 1-8, the respondent must submit within the proposal a Minority and Women's Business Enterprise participation plan. Failure to provide the minority and women's business participation plan at the time of proposal submission may result in the disqualification and rejection of the proposal. Please note that IDOA reserves the right to verify all information included on minority and women's business enterprise participation plans before making final determinations of the respondent's responsiveness.

Additionally, the plan must show that there are racial minority owned enterprises and women owned enterprises participating in the contract. The participation can be, but is not limited to, a subcontractor or second tier participation with common suppliers such as office supplies, courier services and/or janitorial services. The respondent submitting an offer must indicate the name of the racial and women owned firms that will participate in the award, a contact name and phone number, the service to be supplied and the specific dollar amount from this contact that will be directed toward each firm.


The respondent is expected to demonstrate a good faith effort to meet the participation goal of 7% for minority participation and 5% for women owned business participation. A good faith effort consists of documenting the effort that was made to achieve the goal. Respondents are encouraged to contact and work with the Minority Business and Women's Enterprise Division of the Indiana Department of Administration to design a plan to meet established goals.
