

Executive Summary

Beginning October 2013, all Jail Bed Counts now utilize an improved process which allows for more timely and complete notification of inmates sentenced to the Indiana Department of Correction who are housed in local jails awaiting transfer to an intake facility. This has resulted in a greater number of known jail beds.

Definitions

For the purpose of this report, the following definitions apply:

<u>Admission</u> – The means by which an offender enters the custody or jurisdiction of the Indiana Department of Correction. For this report, with the exception of the return of an escapee, this does not include a return from a temporary absence.

<u>Average Daily Population</u> – The sum of the daily beginning counts for a month, divided by that month's number of daily beginning counts.

<u>Beginning Count</u> – The number of offenders physically present at the beginning of the day (ie, 0000:01 hours). <u>Class A Felony</u> – An offense whereby a person convicted of this felony shall be imprisoned for a fixed term of thirty years, with not more than twenty years added for aggravating circumstances, or not more than ten years subtracted for mitigating circumstances.

<u>Class B Felony</u> – An offense whereby a person convicted of this felony shall be imprisoned for a fixed term of ten years, with not more than ten years added for aggravating circumstances, or not more than four years subtracted for mitigating circumstances.

<u>Class C Felony</u> – An offense whereby a person convicted of this felony shall be imprisoned for a fixed term of four years, with not more than four years added for aggravating circumstances, or not more than two years subtracted for mitigating circumstances.

<u>Class D Felony</u> – An offense whereby a person convicted of this felony shall be imprisoned for a fixed term of one and one-half years, with not more than one and one-half years added for aggravating circumstances, or not more than one year subtracted for mitigating circumstances.

<u>County Jail "Back-ups" (Jail Bed Count)</u> – Those offenders who have been committed to the Indiana Department of Correction, but are housed in a county jail until they can be transferred to a Department of Correction intake facility. The county receives \$35.00 per day, per offender, to house these offenders.

Ending Count – The number of offenders physically present at the end of the day (ie, 2400:00 hours).

<u>Felon</u> – A person convicted in any jurisdiction who might have been imprisoned for more than one year.

<u>Level 1 Security Classification</u> – Minimum security level. Facilities which are designated as Level 1 have the least restrictive security measures in place.

<u>Level 2 Security Classification</u> – Medium security level. Facilities which are designated as Level 2 have a moderate degree of security measures in place.

<u>Level 3 Security Classification</u> – Maximum security level. Facilities which are designated as Level 3 have very restrictive security measures in place.

<u>Misdemeanant</u> – A person convicted in any jurisdiction who might have been imprisoned for not more than one year.

<u>Murder</u> - An offense whereby a person convicted of this felony shall be imprisoned for a fixed term of fifty-five years, with not more than ten years added for aggravating circumstances, or not more than ten years subtracted for mitigating circumstances.

<u>Operational Capacity</u> – The total bed capacity of the facility. The capacity of a facility is the number of beds authorized for safe and efficient operation of the facility.

<u>Pre-Dispositional</u> – An individual ordered by the Court to the Indiana Department of Correction for evaluation prior to sentencing.

Recommitment – When an offender returns to IDOC after having served all or some of a sentence unrelated to the current sentence.

<u>Release</u> – The means by which an offender leaves the custody or jurisdiction of the Indiana Department of Correction. For this report, with the exception of an escape, this does not include a temporary absence.

<u>Safekeeper</u> – An individual whom the Court has determined to be in imminent danger of serious bodily injury or death, or who represents a substantial threat to the safety of others, and whom the Court has ordered to the Indiana Department of Correction for custody and security control.

<u>Secure Confinement Units</u> – Denotes maximum control with the most restrictive security measures in place. <u>Vacancy</u> – The number of beds available for assignment.

Indiana Department of Correction Population Summary

- There were 26,614 adult male offenders (including 1,168 county jail "back-ups" and 213 in contracted beds) on November 1, 2013.

 This population is 2% below operational bed capacity for general population.
- ➤ There were 2,705 adult female offenders (including 180 county jail "back-ups" and 130 in contracted beds) on November 1, 2013. This population is 6% below the operational bed capacity.
- ➤ There were 402 juvenile male offenders in the Department's facilities on November 1, 2013. This population is 44% below the operational bed capacity.
- ➤ There were 53 juvenile female offenders in the Department's facilities on November 1, 2013. This population is 66% below the operational bed capacity.
- There were 9,022 adult males on parole in Indiana (8,528 Indiana parolees and 494 other jurisdiction parolees) on November 1, 2013.
- ➤ There were 1,208 adult females on parole in Indiana (1,155 Indiana parolees and 53 other jurisdiction parolees) on November 1, 2013.
- ➤ There were 1,786 adults admitted to IDOC (1,484 male and 302 female) and 1,649 adults released from IDOC (1,383 male and 266 female) in October 2013.
- ➤ There were 92 juveniles admitted to IDOC (80 male and 12 female) and 86 juveniles released from IDOC (68 male and 18 female) in October 2013.



Adult Females Held in County Jails October 2013



November 1, 2013 N = 26,614




