

## *Executive Summary*

Beginning May, 2014, the IDOC Offender Population Statistical Report includes the addition of **Table 20** which reports juvenile parole within the newly implemented **Reintegration Districts**. Below are details concerning this new initiative:

The Division of Youth Services implemented six (6) new positions in April 2014. The JDAI Liaison/Reintegration Specialist works in a specific region of the state (see attached map). They will maintain a caseload of youth released from IDOC onto community supervision (parole) to assist with the coordination of re-entry services aimed at successful transition back into the community. The JDAI Liaison/Reintegration Specialist is a critical position for the success of the Indiana JDAI Statewide Expansion initiative, specifically related to deep-end system reform. The JDAI Liaison/Reintegration Specialist is responsible for working directly with local juvenile justice agencies, court representatives, and community corrections agents to assist in diverting youth from commitment to the Indiana Department of Correction.

The Juvenile Detention Alternatives Initiative (JDAI) is a nationally recognized juvenile justice continuous improvement program, focused on effective case processing, use of data in decision-making, reducing the placement of youth in detention, increasing alternative to detention programs, improving conditions of confinement, and reduction of youth in out-of-home dispositional placement. Indiana has adopted the JDAI philosophy and has developed a statewide expansion initiative, in partnership with the Indiana Department of Correction, Division of Youth Services, the Indiana Supreme Court, and the Indiana Criminal Justice Institute.

## Definitions

For the purpose of this report, the following definitions apply:

**Admission** – The means by which an offender enters the custody or jurisdiction of the Indiana Department of Correction. For this report, with the exception of the return of an escapee, this does not include a return from a temporary absence.

**Average Daily Population** – The sum of the daily beginning counts for a month, divided by that month's number of daily beginning counts.

**Beginning Count** – The number of offenders physically present at the beginning of the day (ie, 0000:01 hours).

**Class A Felony** – An offense whereby a person convicted of this felony shall be imprisoned for a fixed term of thirty years, with not more than twenty years added for aggravating circumstances, or not more than ten years subtracted for mitigating circumstances.

**Class B Felony** – An offense whereby a person convicted of this felony shall be imprisoned for a fixed term of ten years, with not more than ten years added for aggravating circumstances, or not more than four years subtracted for mitigating circumstances.

**Class C Felony** – An offense whereby a person convicted of this felony shall be imprisoned for a fixed term of four years, with not more than four years added for aggravating circumstances, or not more than two years subtracted for mitigating circumstances.

**Class D Felony** – An offense whereby a person convicted of this felony shall be imprisoned for a fixed term of one and one-half years, with not more than one and one-half years added for aggravating circumstances, or not more than one year subtracted for mitigating circumstances.

**County Jail "Back-ups" (Jail Bed Count)** – Those offenders who have been committed to the Indiana Department of Correction, but are housed in a county jail until they can be transferred to a Department of Correction intake facility. The county receives \$35.00 per day, per offender, to house these offenders.

**Ending Count** – The number of offenders physically present at the end of the day (ie, 2400:00 hours).

**Felon** – A person convicted in any jurisdiction who might have been imprisoned for more than one year.

**Level 1 Security Classification** – Minimum security level. Facilities which are designated as Level 1 have the least restrictive security measures in place.

**Level 2 Security Classification** – Medium security level. Facilities which are designated as Level 2 have a moderate degree of security measures in place.

**Level 3 Security Classification** – Maximum security level. Facilities which are designated as Level 3 have very restrictive security measures in place.

**Misdemeanant** – A person convicted in any jurisdiction who might have been imprisoned for not more than one year.

**Murder** - An offense whereby a person convicted of this felony shall be imprisoned for a fixed term of fifty-five years, with not more than ten years added for aggravating circumstances, or not more than ten years subtracted for mitigating circumstances.

**Operational Capacity** – The total bed capacity of the facility. The capacity of a facility is the number of beds authorized for safe and efficient operation of the facility.

**Pre-Dispositional** – An individual ordered by the Court to the Indiana Department of Correction for evaluation prior to sentencing.

**Recommitment** – When an offender returns to IDOC after having served all or some of a sentence unrelated to the current sentence.

**Release** – The means by which an offender leaves the custody or jurisdiction of the Indiana Department of Correction. For this report, with the exception of an escapee, this does not include a temporary absence.

**Safekeeper** – An individual whom the Court has determined to be in imminent danger of serious bodily injury or death, or who represents a substantial threat to the safety of others, and whom the Court has ordered to the Indiana Department of Correction for custody and security control.

**Secure Confinement Units** – Denotes maximum control with the most restrictive security measures in place.

**Vacancy** – The number of beds available for assignment.

## **Indiana Department of Correction Population Summary**

- There were 24,815 adult male offenders (including 505 county jail “back-ups” and 88 in contracted beds) on January 1, 2016. This population is 5% below operational bed capacity for general population.
- There were 2,540 adult female offenders (including 91 county jail “back-ups” and 85 in contracted beds) on January 1, 2016. This population is 10% below the operational bed capacity.
- There were 399 juvenile male offenders in the Department’s facilities on January 1, 2016. This population is 44% below the operational bed capacity.
- There were 57 juvenile female offenders in the Department’s facilities on January 1, 2016. This population is 64% below the operational bed capacity.
- There were 8,362 adult males on parole in Indiana (7,813 Indiana parolees and 549 other jurisdiction parolees) on January 1, 2016.
- There were 1,037 adult females on parole in Indiana (966 Indiana parolees and 71 other jurisdiction parolees) on January 1, 2016.
- There were 1,169 adults admitted to IDOC (981 male and 188 female) and 1,292 adults released from IDOC (1,090 male and 202 female) in December 2015.
- There were 64 juveniles admitted to IDOC (51 male and 13 female) and 81 juveniles released from IDOC (73 male and 8 female) in December 2015.





### Average Daily Adult Female Offender Populations Calendar Year 2015









### Average Daily Adult Male Offender Populations Calendar Year 2015




### Adult Males Held in County Jails




