





## ADULT MALE INCARCERATED POPULATION ON JANUARY 1 EACH YEAR 1986 - 2006





## ADULT POPULATION BY FACILITY






## ADULT POPULATION BY OFFENDER SECURITY LEVEL




## ADULT POPULATION BY MOST SERIOUS OFFENSE LEVEL





## ADULT NEW ADMISSIONS BY RACE







## ADULT NEW ADMISSIONS BY OFFENSE CATEGORY Calendar Year 2005





## ADULT RELEASES BY TYPE OF RELEASE Calendar Year 2005




## JUVENILE MALE INCARCERATED POPULATION ON JANUARY 1 EACH YEAR 1986 - 2006







## JUVENILE POPULATION BY RACE







## JUVENILE NEW ADMISSIONS BY AGE AT INTAKE





## JUVENILE RELEASES BY TYPE OF RELEASE Calendar Year 2005







## ACTIVE EMPLOYEES BY JOB TYPE



## ACTIVE EMPLOYEES BY RACE




