Correctional Police Officers Arrest Woman for Sexual Misconduct

CARLISLE, IN – Today the Office of Investigations & Intelligence (OII) at Wabash Valley Correctional Facility interviewed Aramark employee Courtney Secrest regarding a possible romantic relationship between herself and an offender. The interview was conducted by OII Supervisor Keith McDonald and Investigator Jodeana Raney. During the interview Secrest admitted to having an inappropriate relationship with an offender.

“We are steadfast in maintaining safety and security for everyone in our custody,” said Warden Richard Brown. “The Department is entrusted by the public to uphold the highest standards of the law; this will be no exception.”

Ms. Secrest was arrested for Sexual Misconduct, a Level 5 Felony, and transported to Sullivan County Jail. Ms. Secrest is presumed innocent until proven guilty in a court of law.
