Indiana State Prison Confirms Walk-Away of Low-Level Offender

Michigan City, Ind. – Officials confirm Travis Hornett, of Waterloo, has walked-away from the low-level facility located at the Indiana State Prison.

At approximately 11:00 a.m. the Indiana State Prison in Michigan City, Indiana discovered Offender Travis Hornett of Waterloo, missing from his outside work detail at the facility's low-security housing unit. Hornett, as minimum security offender, was part of an outside maintenance work crew.

Offender Hornett is a 39 year-old white male, approximately 5' 5" tall, weighing approximately 160 pounds. He was sentenced out of DeKalb County on September 14, 2018, to serve a five year sentence for the crime of Burglary, a Level 5 felony.

The Indiana State Prison and the Department of Correction's Fugitive Apprehension Unit is working with Indiana State Police, U.S. Marshalls and local law enforcement to ensure his capture and return to custody. A warrant has been issued for his arrest.
