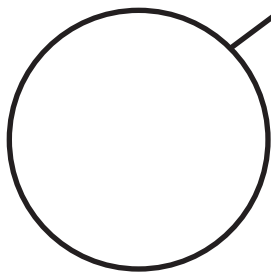

How **ALERT** Works

1. Register by visiting <http://indianasavin.in.gov> or by calling toll free at (866) 891-0330.
2. Provide your telephone number(s) and email address(es) for the facilities from which you wish to receive notification.
3. ALERT will automatically contact you if an escape or emergency occurs.
4. A follow-up message will be sent notifying you of the offender's re-capture or the resolution of the emergency situation.

Timely, Accurate & Free Notification

Notifying residents in an emergency used to be a long and tedious process. Officials had to rely on door-to-door contact or the media to get the word out.

When an emergency occurs, officials can access the ALERT Notification Service and notify nearby residents within minutes.

ESCAPE In the event of an escape, registrants receive detailed information about the escapee, including physical description and time of escape.

OTHER EMERGENCIES Registrants will also be notified of emergency situations in and around correctional facilities.

There is no cost for this service and citizens can register now.
