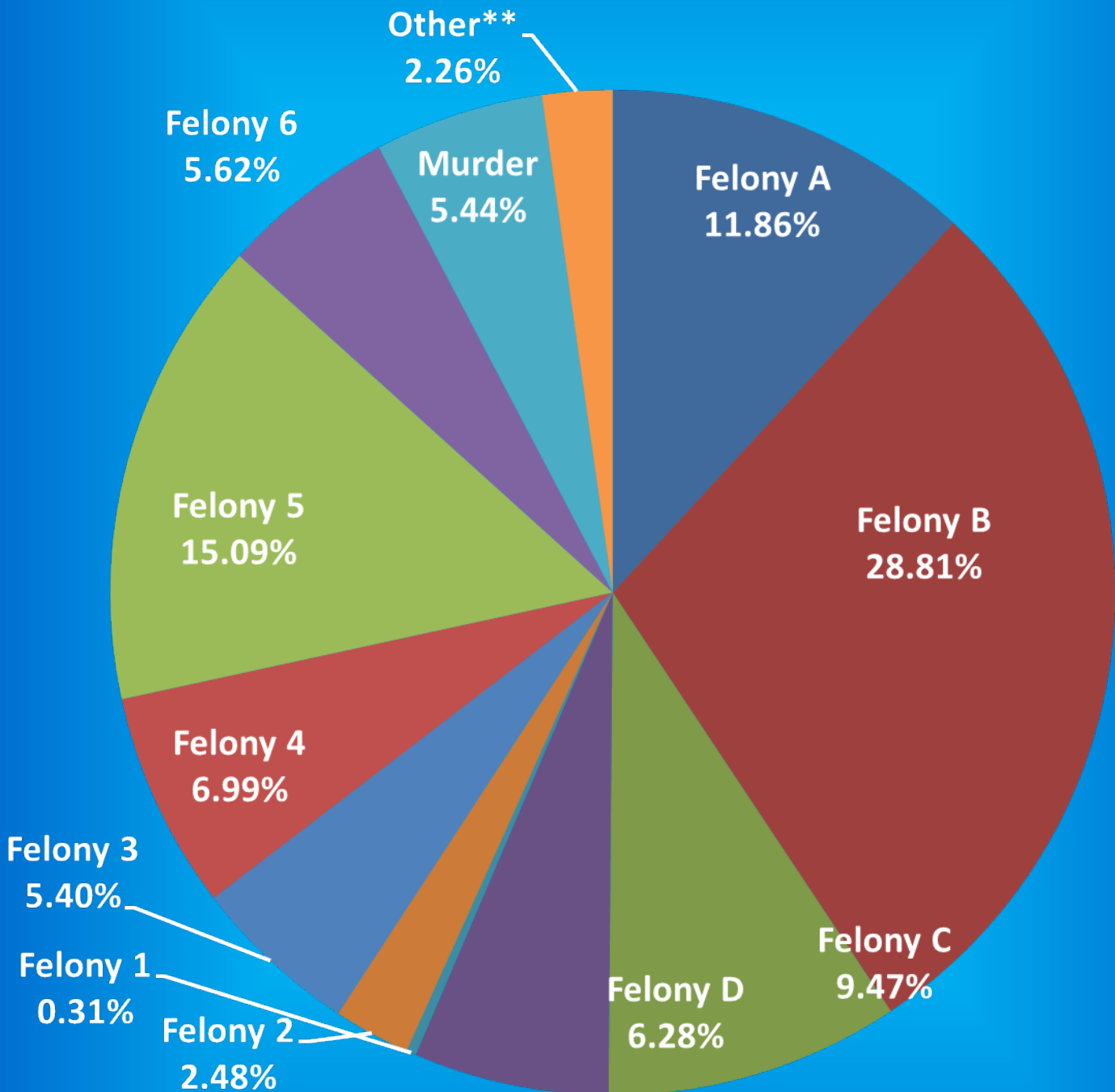

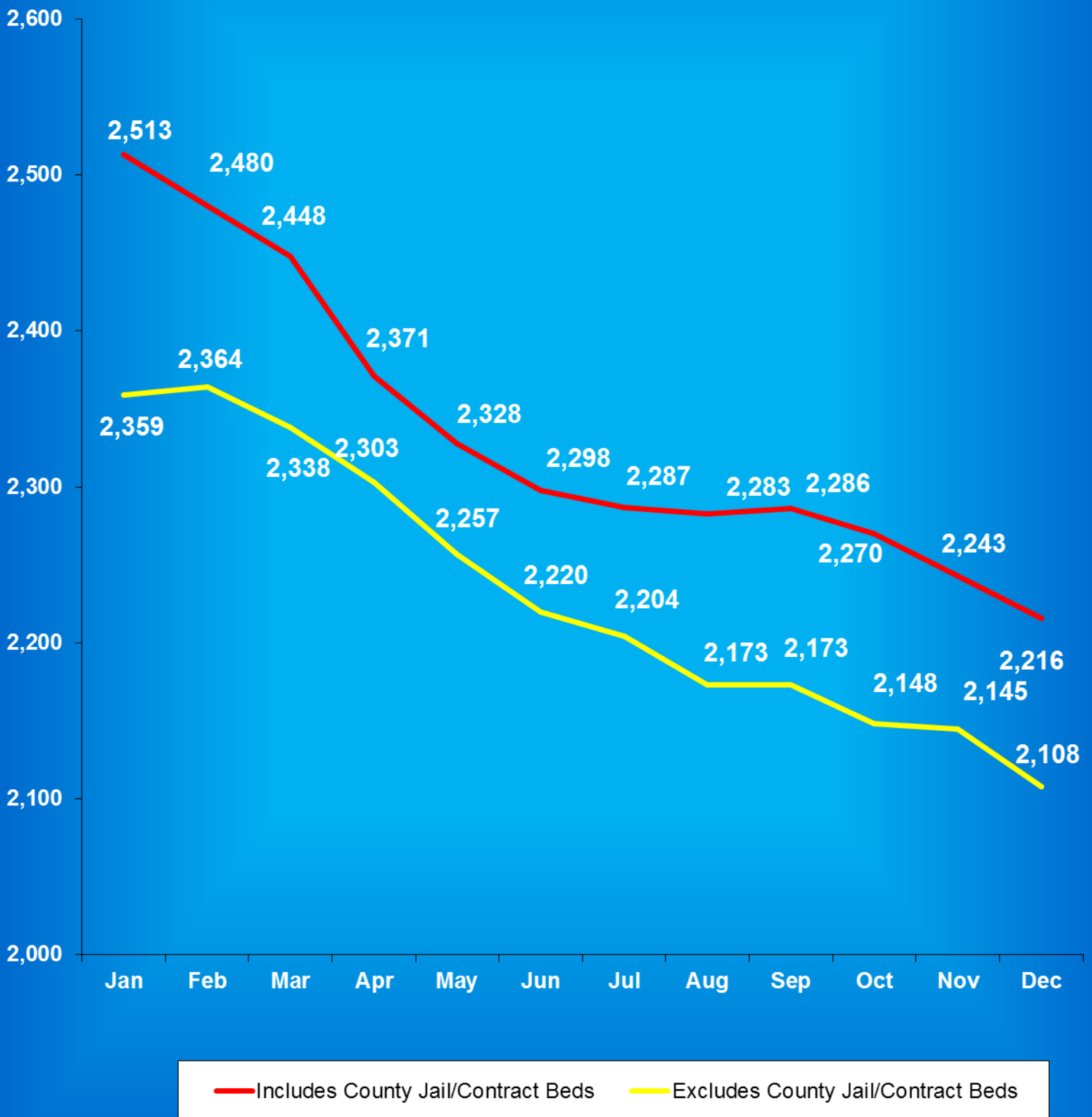

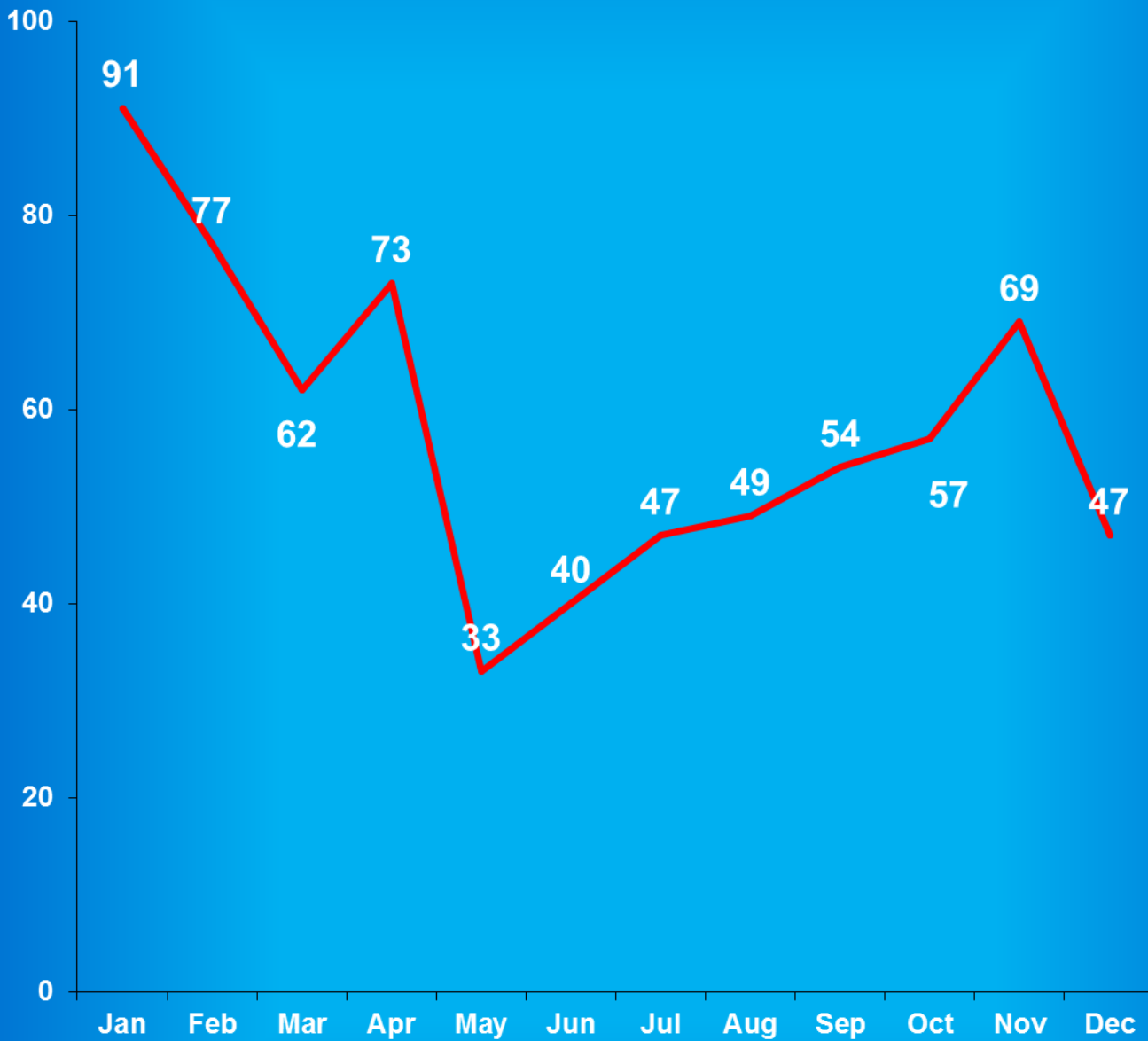
Average Daily Adult Female Offender Populations

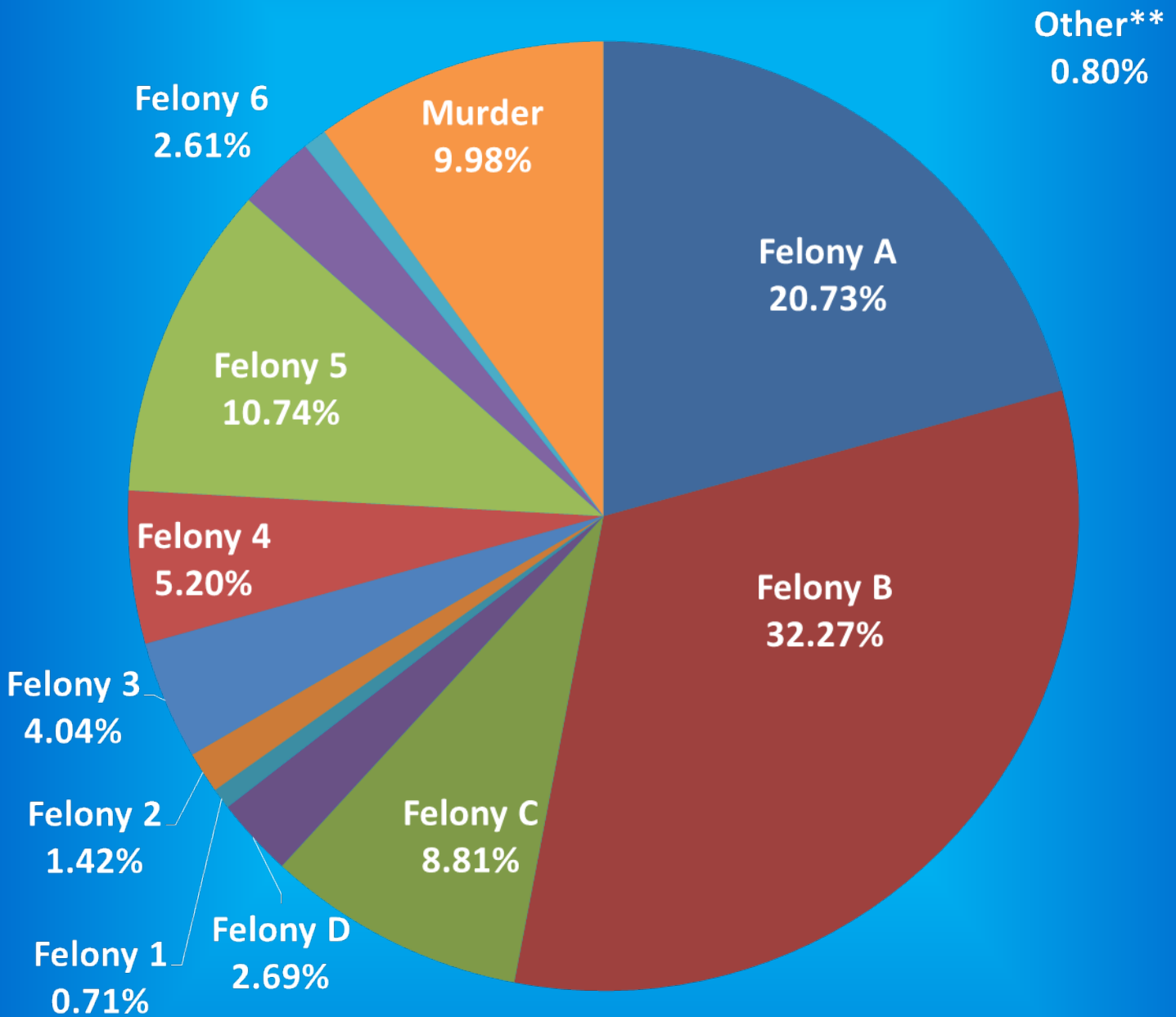

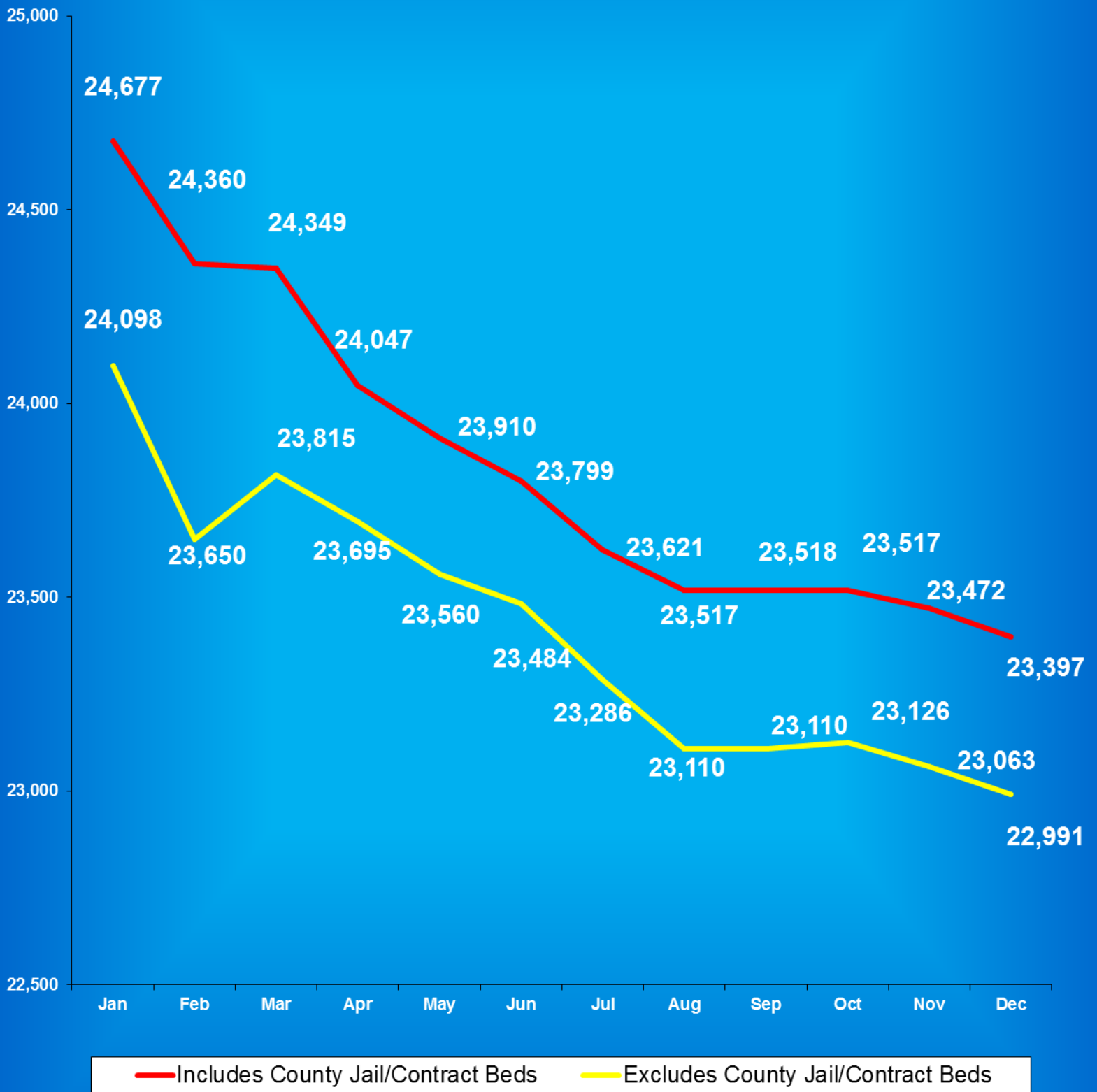

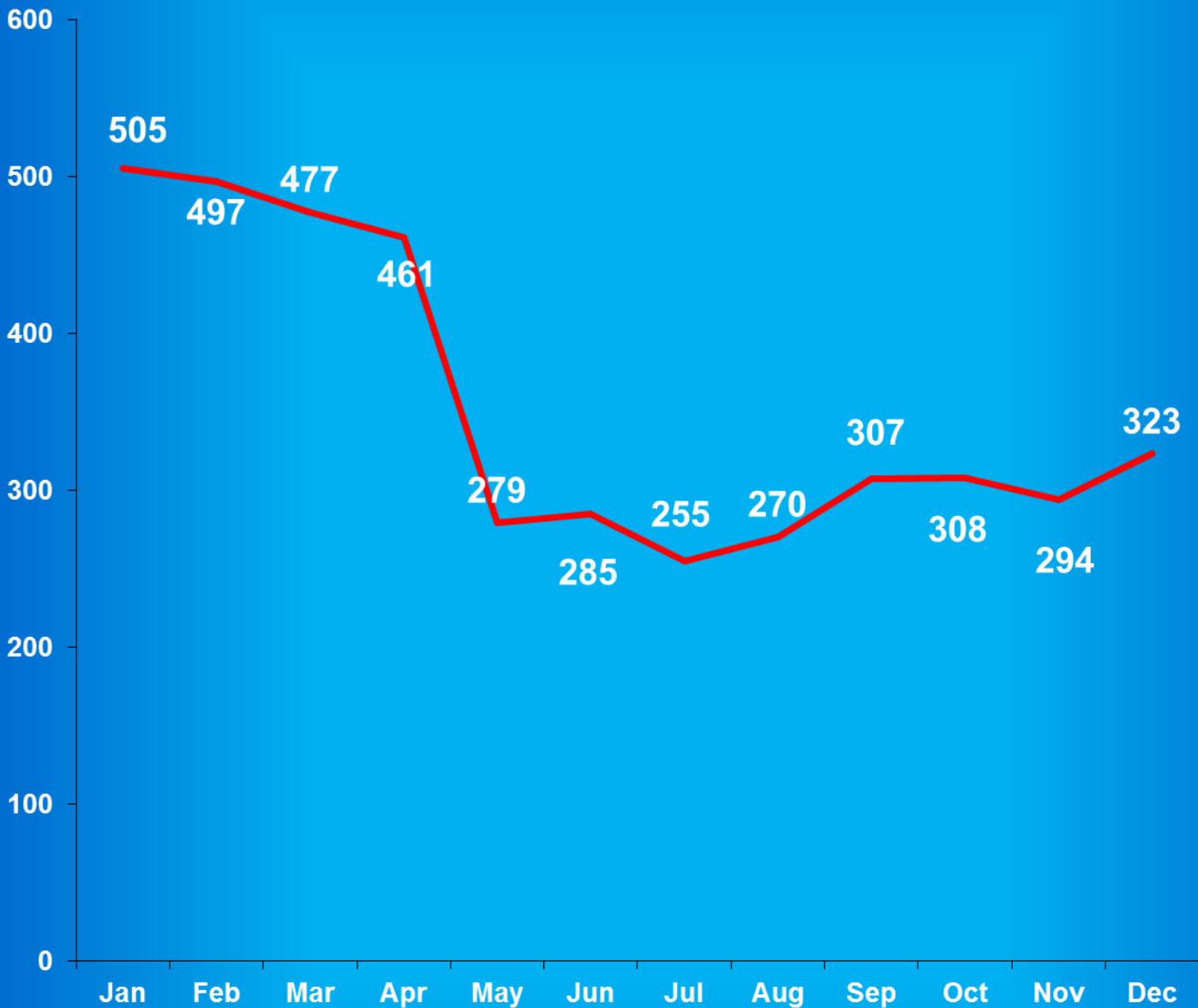
Average Daily Adult Male Offender Populations Calendar Year 2016

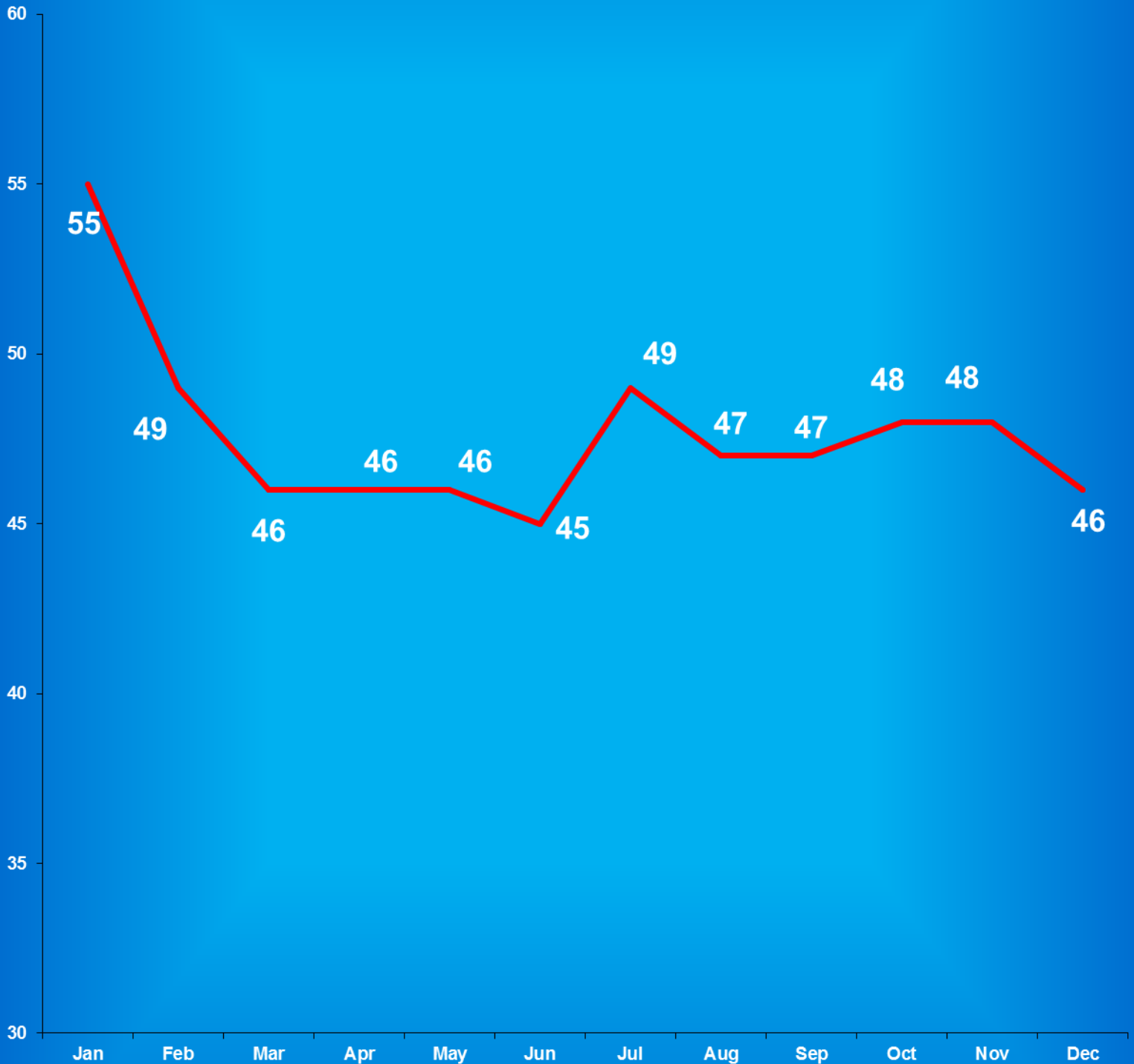

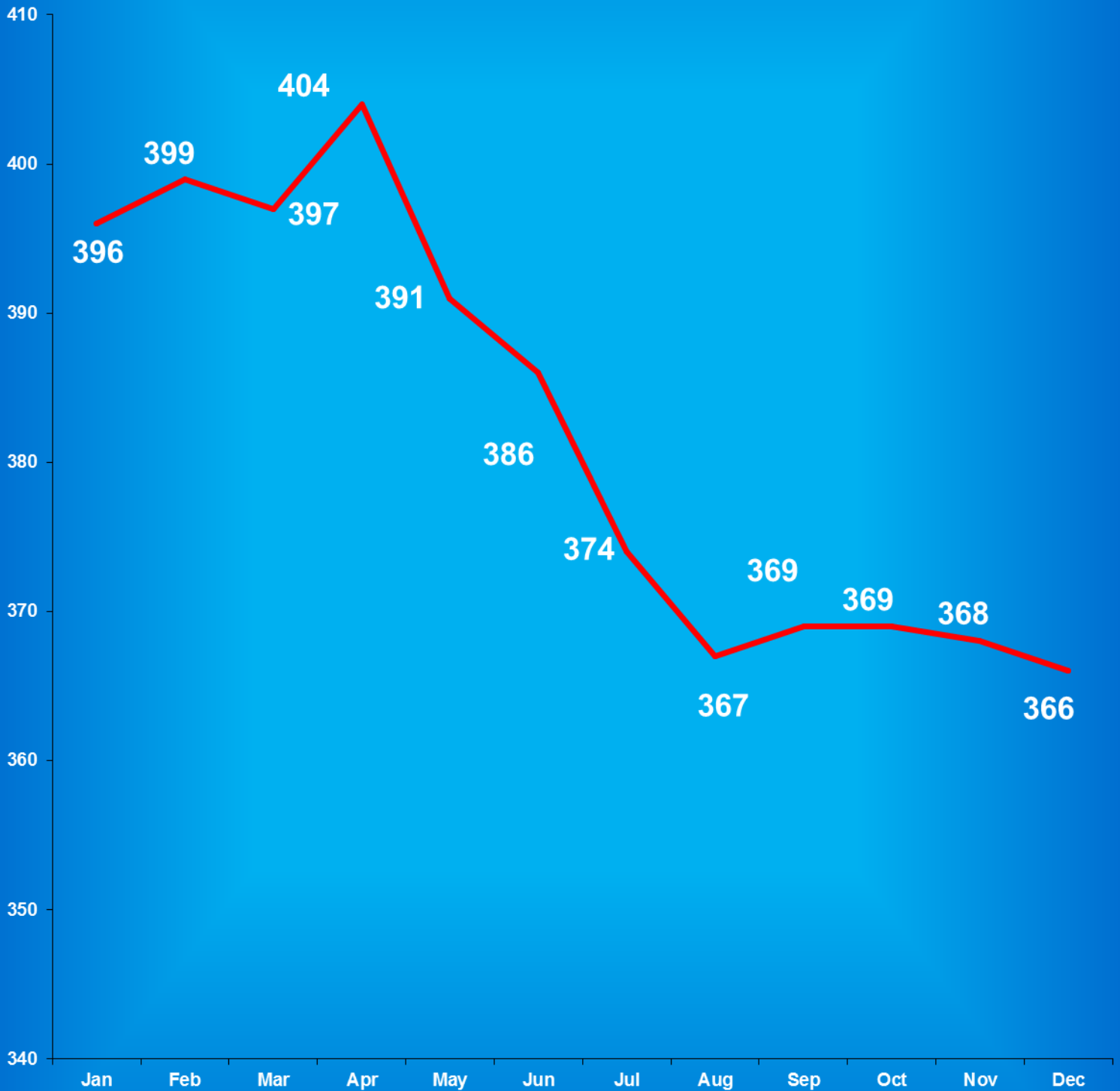
