SBCRC has over 25 committed volunteers that play an active role in carrying out the mission of the re-entry center program. These volunteers have donated hundreds of hours to the betterment of the program, the residents, and the communities we serve. They provide classes that include Take Ten, Circles, Narcotics Anonymous, Alcoholics Anonymous, Book Club, Money Smarts, Bible Study, and Rebuilding Credit 101. "In addition to these courses, these amazing volunteers assist residents with preparing for TASC testing, transportation to religious services, community service, and mentor programs, and family events." Warden Bowen stated.
