Wabash Valley Correctional Facility Minimum-Security Walk Away

Carlisle, Indiana (August 23, 2011) – A search is underway for a walk away from the Wabash Valley Correctional Facility, minimum-security.

34-year-old Jeremy Sharp, a grounds crew worker was discovered missing just after 10:30a.m. He is described as a white male, five feet eight inches tall, 160 pounds, medium build, blue eyes, brown hair, fair complexion.

Sharp was serving a 10 year sentence on a Vigo County Dealing in Cocaine/Narcotic conviction.

Sharp was last seen operating a facility mowing tractor. He was wearing a yellow reflective vest, yellow clothing.

If you spot this individual do not approach, please contact the nearest law enforcement agency. Facility K-9 and Emergency Squad staff are involved in the search, area law enforcement agencies have been notified.
