

#### Definitions

For this report, the following definitions apply:

<u>Admission</u> – The means by which an offender enters the custody or jurisdiction of the Indiana Department of Correction. For this report, except for the return of an escapee, this does not include a return from a temporary absence.

<u>Average Daily Population</u> – The sum of the daily beginning counts for a month, divided by that month's number of daily beginning counts.

**<u>Beginning Count</u>** – The number of offenders physically present at the beginning of the day (ie, 0000:01 hours). <u>**Class A Felony**</u> – An offense whereby a person convicted of this felony shall be imprisoned for a fixed term of thirty years, with not more than twenty years added for aggravating circumstances, or not more than ten years subtracted for mitigating circumstances.

<u>**Class B Felony**</u> – An offense whereby a person convicted of this felony shall be imprisoned for a fixed term of ten years, with not more than ten years added for aggravating circumstances, or not more than four years sub-tracted for mitigating circumstances.

<u>**Class C Felony**</u> – An offense whereby a person convicted of this felony shall be imprisoned for a fixed term of four years, with not more than four years added for aggravating circumstances, or not more than two years sub-tracted for mitigating circumstances.

<u>Class D Felony</u> – An offense whereby a person convicted of this felony shall be imprisoned for a fixed term of one and one-half years, with not more than one and one-half years added for aggravating circumstances, or not more than one year subtracted for mitigating circumstances.

<u>Class 1 Felony</u> – An offense whereby a person convicted of this felony shall be imprisoned with a sentence range of 20-40 years, with not more than twenty years added as a habitual offender enhancement.

<u>Class 2 Felony</u> – An offense whereby a person convicted of this felony shall be imprisoned with a sentence range of 10-30 years, with not more than twenty years added as a habitual offender enhancement.

<u>Class 3 Felony</u> – An offense whereby a person convicted of this felony shall be imprisoned with a sentence range of 3-16 years, with not more than twenty years added as a habitual offender enhancement.

<u>Class 4 Felony</u> – An offense whereby a person convicted of this felony shall be imprisoned with a sentence range of 2-12 years, with not more than twenty years added as a habitual offender enhancement.

<u>Class 5 Felony</u> – An offense whereby a person convicted of this felony shall be imprisoned with a sentence range of 1-6 years, with not more than six years added as a habitual offender enhancement.

<u>Class 6 Felony</u> – An offense whereby a person convicted of this felony shall be imprisoned with a sentence range of 0.5-2.5 years, with not more than six years added as a habitual offender enhancement.

<u>Contracted Beds</u> - Those offenders who have been committed to the Indiana Department of Correction but are housed in a local work release facility under contract of a 3rd party provider.

<u>County Jail "Back-ups" (Jail Bed Count)</u> – Those offenders who have been committed to the Indiana Department of Correction but are housed in a county jail until they can be transferred to a Department of Correction intake facility. The county receives \$35.00 per day, per offender, to house these offenders.

**Ending Count** – The number of offenders physically present at the end of the day (i.e., 2400:00 hours).

Felon – A person convicted in any jurisdiction who might have been imprisoned for more than one year.

<u>Murder</u> - An offense whereby a person convicted of this felony shall be imprisoned for a fixed term of fifty-five years, with not more than ten years added for aggravating circumstances, or not more than ten years subtracted for mitigating circumstances.

#### **Definitions Continued**

<u>**Operational Capacity**</u> – The total bed capacity of the facility. The capacity of a facility is the number of beds authorized for safe and efficient operation of the facility.

<u>**Pre-Dispositional**</u> – An individual ordered by the Court to the Indiana Department of Correction for evaluation prior to sentencing.

<u>**Release**</u> – The means by which an offender leaves the custody or jurisdiction of the Indiana Department of Correction. For this report, except for an escape, this does not include a temporary absence.

<u>Safekeeper</u> – An individual whom the Court has determined to be in imminent danger of serious bodily injury or death, or who represents a substantial threat to the safety of others, and whom the Court has ordered to the Indiana Department of Correction for custody and security control.

<u>Maximum Level Facilities</u> – Maximum security facilities have very restrictive security measures and housing is celled space.

<u>Medium Level Facilities</u> – Medium security facilities have moderate degree of security measures and housing consists of dormitories and celled space.

<u>Minimum Level Facilities</u> – Minimum Security Facilities have the least restrictive security measures and housing is dormitory style. Also included as minimum security are work release program offenders who leave the facility for outside employment but return nightly.

<u>Intake Facilities</u> – Intake facilities are designated to receive newly committed adult offenders. During the intake process each offender is evaluated through interviews, reports and diagnostic tests. This evaluation forms the basis of the offenders' facility and program assignment.

<u>Secure Housing Units</u> – Denotes maximum control with the most restrictive security measures in place. <u>Vacancy</u> – The number of beds available for assignment.

<u>Juvenile Diagnostic/Walkthrough</u> – A Juvenile court can order a youth to the Department of Correction to be temporarily committed for not more than 14 days (excluding Saturdays, Sundays, and Legal holidays) for the purpose of an evaluation. The youth must be adjudicated delinquent, and the order must be prior to disposition. The department will send a report to the court of the written findings.

#### Indiana Department of Correction Population Summary

- There were 21,202 adult male offenders (including 396 county jail "back-ups" and 79 in contracted beds) on September 01, 2022. This population is 9% below operational bed capacity for general population.
- There were 2,168 adult female offenders (including 74 county jail "back-ups" and 34 in contracted beds) on September 01, 2022. This population is 21% below the operational bed capacity.
- There were 273 juvenile male offenders in the Department's facilities on September 01, 2022. This population is 50% below the operational bed capacity.
- There were 38 juvenile female offenders in the Department's facilities on September 01, 2022. This population is 39% below the operational bed capacity.
- There were 5,741 adult males on parole in Indiana (5,249 Indiana parolees and 492 other jurisdiction parolees) on September 01, 2022.
- There were 580 adult females on parole in Indiana (509 Indiana parolees and 71 other jurisdiction parolees) on September 01, 2022.
- There were 706 adults admitted to IDOC (600 males and 106 females) and 885 adults released from IDOC (769 males and 116 females) in August 2022.
- There were 35 juveniles admitted to IDOC (33 males and 2 female) and 29 juveniles released from IDOC (25 males and 4 females) in August 2022.




### Indiana Department of Correction Graph B

Adult Females Held in County Jails August 2022









Average Daily Juvenile Female Offender Populations Calendar Year 2022






Average Daily Juvenile Male Offender Populations Calendar Year 2022
