Pre-licensing and Continuing Education

Updated Course Materials



- Pre-Licensing course material should follow but not be limited to the topic specific Course Outline(s) published and posted to the IDOI website
<https://www.in.gov/idoi/2480.htm>
 - Applicants should not be solely taught to pass the exam but be properly educated on the insurance products, applicable laws, processes and Line of Authority to which they have applied
- Continuing Education (online or classroom) course material is required to be reviewed and approved by the Department of Insurance before being published and delivered

- Effective June 1, 2019 any updates to course materials must be submitted to the IDOI **before** being implemented and delivered to include:
 - Pre-licensing and Continuing Education
 - Reprinted or republished books
 - Slideshow presentations
 - Course handouts
 - Course outline/Agendas

Education Advisory Council



- Meets once monthly on the 2nd Thursday of each Month
- Courses must be submitted at least one week prior to Advisory Council meeting, in order to be reviewed and approved for that particular month
- Course submissions must include:
 - Course material
 - Agenda with time-line or topic intervals
 - Outline
 - Word count

Course Audits



- IDOI representative may appear unannounced in classroom or registered online course to ensure adherence and compliance
 - Adherence to delivery of course material as submitted and approved
 - Class duration: No early outs
 - Sign in/Sign out: Late arrivals refused admittance or reduced CE hours received
 - Frequent departure from the class: Reduced hours received
 - Course and Provider approval revoked or not renewed



Pre-licensing Provider Pass Ratio Reports

- Data pulled by course completions submitted online by providers
- Imperative that course completions are entered correctly and as soon as possible following course completion
 - Untimely submission impacts licensee application approval
- Below 45% overall passing rate is cause for enforcement action
 - Course approval withdrawn and removed from Sircon

Common Reasons for License Denials

- Any felony conviction
- Violent or dishonest misdemeanors (e.g., Battery, Conversion)
- Other professional license revocations
- Applicants can request an Appeal if they disagree with the IDOI decision

License Renewals



- Effective January 2019 the license renewal period extended to 90 days
- IDOI sends *courtesy* reminders via the email address on record 90 days before license expiration
 - License renewal not contingent on receipt of reminder
 - Check your spam folder
- The individual agent is responsible to renew their individual Producer License timely, not the agency or company

- Submit form:
 - License Cancellation or Surrender
 - Legal name changes
 - Add or remove Alias or DBA

- No form needed (online updates):
 - Contact information (address, and email telephone) updates
 - DRLP changes must be done online for producers and adjusters (not navigators) at www.nipr.com or www.sircon.com
 - IDOI no longer issues clearance letters

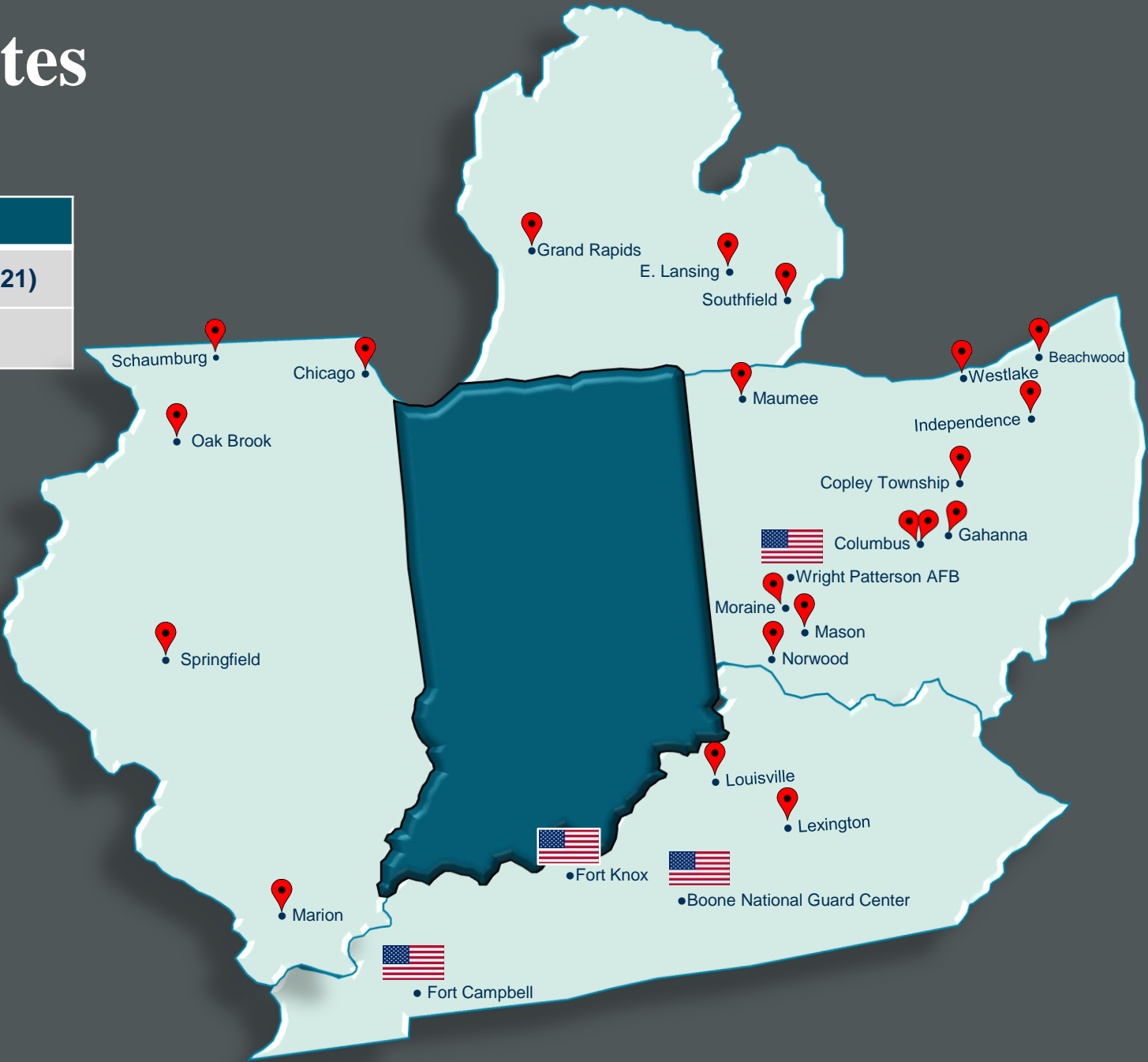

Group scheduling

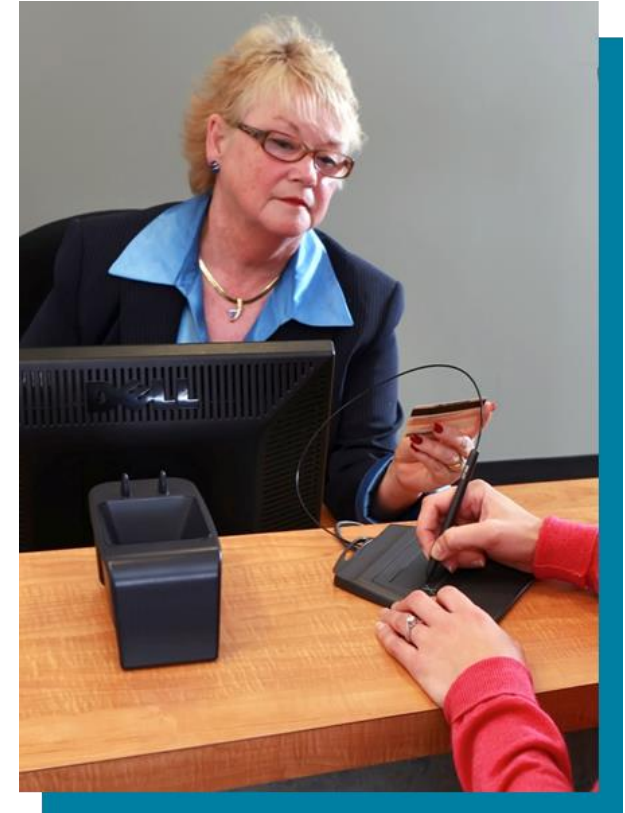

Exam delivery


- Identification requirements:

 - **Name on the identification must exactly match the name on the registration**
- Candidate must bring course completion certificate (or other required documentation)
- Candidate will have a photo and digital signature captured
- All personal belongings, including watches and wallets, must be stored in a locker provided by the test center
- Candidate should arrive 30 minutes prior to the scheduled exam time to allow adequate time for check-in



Pretest questions

- Are being “tried out” to assess if they are:
 - Too easy
 - Too difficult
- Do not count toward the candidate’s final score
- Are mixed in with scored items, so they are indistinguishable to the candidate
- For example, the Indiana Life Examination consists of:
 - General Knowledge section has 50 scored + 10 pretest items
 - State section has 30 scored + 5 pretest items



Pearson VUE styles and standards

- All 4-option multiple-choice items (questions)
 - Answer options are A, B, C, & D
- Completion vs question item stems
- No “trick” items
- All items have equal weighting (except pretest – no weight)
- No penalty for guessing



Pearson VUE styles and standards

- Reviewed and updated major lines exams
 - Life
 - Health
 - Life/Health
 - Property/Casualty
 - Personal Lines
- Limited Lines exams left as is until we can convene a group of subject matter experts
 - Bail/Recovery
 - Surplus Lines
 - Public Adjuster
 - Navigator



Scoring and equating

- Exam forms are reliable:
 - Two candidates possessing equal ability levels should receive comparable exam scores regardless of:
 - Exam form
 - Test center location
 - Date of exam
- Passing score for Indiana is a 70 on a scale ranging from 0-100
- Diagnostics are provided on failing score reports
- Passing point is a “level of difficulty” established by a cut-score study at minimum level of competence
 - Standard setting conducted with Indiana subject matter experts in mid-April
