- An Ancillary Provider (AP) pays surcharge at 100% of the underlying premium (or the \$100 statutory minimum, whichever is greater).
- An AP may be considered an employee of a corporation and may share the limits of a corporation, unless they are a member of a partnership or professional corporation per IC 34-18-4-4.
- The surcharge for a Reporting Endorsement for an AP is 100% of the underlying tail policy premium (or the \$100 statutory minimum, whichever is greater).
- *The Corporate & Other Legal Entities ISO Code (80999) does not apply to Hospitals / Psychiatric Hospitals (90000) or Nursing Homes (80923).

Independent Ancillary Providers

- Independent Ancillary Provider (IAP) rates are a percentage of the Physician Class 1 rate.
- IAP ISO Codes are defined by license, not job function. For example, an individual who is licensed as both a Registered Nurse and a Certified Registered Nurse Anesthetist (CRNA) must use the CRNA ISO Code and pay the CRNA surcharge regardless of their job duties.
- An IAP may only share in the limits of a Hospital, Psychiatric Hospital, or Nursing Home per 760 IAC 1-21-10(f); they may not share in the limits of a Corporation.
- Part-time discounts are allowed.
