Granting Bail Bond Division's Objections in Part,
Granting Respondent's Objection in Part and
Modifying ALJ's Recommended Order

The Acting Commissioner of the Indiana Department of Insurance, Doug Webber, having read and reviewed the Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) John Kissling's Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and Recommended Order, Indiana Department of Insurance Bail Bond Division's Objections to Recommended Order and Respondent's Objection to Recommended Order, and now being duly advised in the premises **GRANTS** Bail Bond Division's objections in part and **GRANTS** Respondent's objection in part and pursuant to Indiana Code 4-21.5-3-29, as ultimate authority in this case issues this Final Order **MODIFYING** ALJ Kissling's Recommended Order of February 8, 2010, by suspending Respondent's bail agent license for a period of thirty (30) days, removing Recommended Order paragraph #3, changing in the Recommended Order any place that names Janella Webster to Lionel E. Wooden and extending Respondent's fine due date to ninety (90) days after the issuance of this Final Order.

Grant of Bail Bond Division's Objections in Part

The Commissioner grants the following objections:

1. The typographical error in the first paragraph of ALJ's Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and Recommended Order that names Janella Webster as the Respondent is changed to reflect the actual Respondent Lionel E. Wooden.
2. Indiana Code § 27-10-3-8(a)(2) mandates that the Commissioner suspend or revoke respondents bail agent license for a violation of Indiana law. Respondent was found to have violated Ind. Code § 27-10-3-14 and therefore the Commissioner is obligated to suspend or revoke Respondent's bail agent license.

Grant of Respondent's Objections in Part

The Commissioner grants the following objection:

1. Respondent's request for an extended period of ninety (90) days to pay his fine is granted.

Findings of Fact & Conclusion of Law


ALJ's Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law are incorporated into this Order.

1. Respondent's bail agent license #5108 shall be suspended for a period of thirty (30) days from the issuance of this Final Order.
