FINAL ORDER

The Indiana Department of Insurance (“Department”) and DeShawn D. The Commissioner, after reviewing the Agreed Entry, finds it has been entered into fairly and without fraud, duress or undue influence, and is fair and equitable between the parties. The Commissioner hereby incorporates the Agreed Entry as if fully set forth as attached as Exhibit A herein, and approves and adopts in full the Agreed Entry as a resolution of this matter.


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Commissioner of Insurance:

1. Respondent will apply to the Department for consent under 18 U.S.C. 1033 Federal Violent Crime Control and Law Enforcement Act of 1994 within thirty (30) days of the Commissioner’s Final Order.
2. Respondent’s Producer License will be placed on a probationary status for one (1)

year. The terms of the probation will correspond with those imposed by the
Monroe Circuit Court, Indiana, under cause number 53-CO05 0902FB00116.

3. Respondent will not violate Indiana Code.

AGREED ENTRY

This Agreed Entry is executed by Nikolas P. Mann, Attorney for and on behalf of the State of Indiana, Department of Insurance ("Department"), and DeShawn D. Benson, a licensed resident insurance agent. This Agreed Entry is subject to the review and approval of Carol Cutter, Commissioner, Indiana Department of Insurance.

WHEREAS, Respondent is a resident of Indiana, and;

WHEREAS, Respondent holds Resident Insurance Producer License Number 599158, and;

WHEREAS, Respondent was convicted of Possession of Cocaine, a class D felony, and;

WHEREAS, Respondent disclosed the conviction to the Department in a timely manner in accordance with Indiana Code, and;

WHEREAS, the Department and Respondent desire to resolve their differences and settle the issues without a hearing or the necessity of the filing of a statement of charges;

IT IS THEREFORE, NOW AGREED by and between the parties as follows:

1. The Commissioner has jurisdiction over the subject matter of and the parties to this Agreed Entry.
2. This Agreed Entry is executed voluntarily by the parties.
3. Respondent voluntarily and freely waives his right to a public hearing.
4. Respondent voluntarily and freely waives his right to petition for judicial review of this agreement and the Commissioner's Final Order.
5. Respondent was convicted of Possession of Cocaine, a class D felony.
6. Respondent's conduct is in violation of Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(6).
7. Respondent will apply to the Department for consent under 18 U.S.C. 1033 Federal Violent Crime Control and Law Enforcement Act of 1994 within thirty (30) days of the Commissioner's Final Order.
9. Respondent's Producer License will be placed on a probationary status for one (1) year. The terms of the probation will correspond with those imposed by the Monroe Circuit Court, Indiana, under cause number 53-CO05 0902FB00116.
10. Respondent will not violate Indiana Code.
11. The Department agrees to accept Respondent's compliance with the terms of this agreement as full resolution of the issues regarding Respondent's producer license.

12. Respondent has carefully read and examined this agreement and fully understands its terms.
