**ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER**  
**NOTICE OF NONRENEWAL OF LICENSE**

The Indiana Department of Insurance, pursuant to the Indiana Administrative Act, Indiana Code 4-21.5-1 et seq. and Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12, hereby gives notice to Paul B.

Thompson ("Respondent") of the following Administrative Order:

1. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b) provides that "The commissioner may levy a civil penalty, place an insurance producer on probation, suspend an insurance producer's license, revoke and insurance producer's license for a period of years, permanently revoke an insurance producer's license, or refuse to issue or renew an insurance producer license, or take any combination of these actions, ...".

2. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(d) provides that when the Commissioner refuses to renew a license, the Commissioner shall notify the Respondent, in writing, of the reasons for the nonrenewal.

3. Respondent is a licensed non-resident insurance producer within the State of Indiana, holding license number 629752.

4. Respondent's license expired on December 31, 2010.

5. On or about January 4, 2011, the Department was notified by Respondent that he had failed to disclose a felony conviction on his license application in December 2008.

6. A review of Respondent's NAIC RIRS report revealed Respondent also failed to notify the Department of administrative actions including fines, probation and revocations, taken against his license in California, Delaware, Missouri, Virginia, Idaho and Missouri.


7. Respondent's conduct, as alleged herein, of providing incorrect, misleading, incomplete, or materially untrue information in a license application is cause for disciplinary action in accordance with Indiana Code 27-1-15.6-12(b)(1).

8. Respondent's failure to notify the Department within 30 days of an administrative action is in violation of Indiana Code 27-1-15.6-17 and is cause for disciplinary action in accordance with Indiana Code 27-1-15.6-12(b)(2).

WHEREFORE, based on the foregoing, the Commissioner of Insurance hereby notifies Respondent that **Respondent's license shall not be renewed.**

WHEREFORE, the Commissioner further notifies Respondent that pursuant to Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-12(d), within sixty (60) days of receiving this Notice, Respondent may make a written demand upon the Commissioner for a hearing to determine the reasonableness of this action. Such a hearing shall be held within thirty (30) days from the date of receipt of Respondent's written demand.
