Eldridge ("Applicant"), an applicant for an Indiana bail agent license. This Agreed Entry is subject to the review and approval of Stephen W. Robertson, Commissioner, Indiana Department of Insurance.

WHEREAS, Applicant applied for an Indiana bail agent license on October 21, 2011; and

WHEREAS, in October 2003, Applicant was convicted of operating a vehicle while intoxicated and driving while suspended, both misdemeanors; and

WHEREAS, in January 2006, Applicant was convicted of resisting law enforcement, a misdemeanor; and

WHEREAS, in July 2007, Applicant was convicted of operating a vehicle while intoxicated, a misdemeanor; and

WHEREAS, from July 2002 to July 2007, Applicant's driver's license was suspended on twenty-two (22) occasions; and

WHEREAS, the parties met on November 28, 2011 and spoke on the telephone on November 30, 2011 and reached a verbal agreement that would allow the parties to resolve the bail agent license issue without the necessity of an administrative hearing;

IT IS THEREFORE, NOW AGREED by and between the parties as follows:

- The Commissioner has jurisdiction over the subject matter and the Applicant.
- 2. This Agreed Entry is executed voluntarily by the parties.
- 3. Applicant voluntarily and freely waives his right to a public hearing concerning his application for a bail agent license.
- 4. Applicant agrees that when his bail agent license is issued, it will be subject to a probationary period of two (2) years from the date of issue.
- 5. Applicant agrees that if his driver's license is suspended, if he is convicted of any crime, or if he violates any bail law during the probation period including being subject to a state tax warrant, it will be treated as a violation of his probation and may result in the permanent revocation of his bail agent license.
- 6. Respondent voluntarily and freely waives his right to petition for judicial review of this agreement and the Commissioner's Final Order.
- 7. Should this Agreed Entry not be accepted by the Commissioner, it is agreed that presentation to and consideration of this Agreed Entry by the Commissioner shall not unfairly or illegally prejudice the Commissioner from further participation in or resolution of these proceedings.
- Respondent has carefully read this agreement and fully understands and accepts its terms.
