


**BEFORE THE INDIANA

## FINAL ORDER

1. Respondent disclosed a conviction for Dealing in Cocaine or Narcotic Drug, in violation of Indiana Code 27-1-15.6-12(b)(6) on his application for a resident insurance producer license.

2. Respondent will submit a completed application for a waiver under 18 U.S.C. 1033 Federal Violent Crime Control and Law Enforcement Act of 1994 (1033)..
3. The Department will issue the Respondent with a Resident Producer License on a Probationary basis. The terms of the probation are as follows. Respondent's license will be placed on a probationary status for one year. Respondent will not violate Indiana insurance laws.
4. Upon the Commissioner's signature of the Final Order, Respondent's Producer License Application and 18 U.S.C. 1033 Federal Violent Crime Control and Law Enforcement Act of 1994 consent will be processed in the normal manner.
5. The Department agrees to accept Respondent's compliance with the terms of this agreement as full resolution of the issues regarding Respondent's producer license application.
