## ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NOTICE OF NONRENEWAL OF LICENSE

The Indiana Department of Insurance, pursuant to the Indiana Administrative Act, Indiana Code 4-21.5-1 et seq. and Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12, hereby gives notice to Logan Blake Cooley ("Respondent") of the following Administrative Order:

- 1. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b) provides that "The commissioner may levy a civil penalty, place an insurance producer on probation, suspend an insurance producer's license, revoke and insurance producer's license for a period of years, permanently revoke an insurance producer's license, or refuse to issue or renew an insurance producer license, or take any combination of these actions, ...".
- 2. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(d) provides that when the Commissioner refuses to renew a license, the Commissioner shall notify the Respondent, in writing, of the reasons for the nonrenewal.
- 3. Respondent is a non-resident insurance producer with the State of Indiana, holding license number 674834.

4. Respondent's license expired on November 30, 2011.

5. The Department received notice of termination for cause from Nationwide Mutual

Insurance Company ("Nationwide") stating Respondent had misrepresented the terms of a

proposed insurance policy on two separate sales solicitations.

6. Respondent's conduct, as alleged herein, is considered to demonstrate

misrepresentation, incompetence and untrustworthiness and is cause for disciplinary action in

accordance with Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(5) and (8).

WHEREFORE, based on the foregoing, the Commissioner of Insurance hereby notifies

Respondent that Respondent's license shall not be renewed.

WHEREFORE, the Commissioner further notifies Respondent that pursuant to Indiana

Code §27-1-15.6-12(d), within sixty (60) days of receiving this Notice, Respondent may make a

written demand upon the Commissioner for a hearing to determine the reasonableness of this

action. Such a hearing shall be held within thirty (30) days from the date of receipt of

Respondent's written demand.
