- 5. Applicant shall pay a civil penalty in the amount of five hundred dollars and 00/100 (\$500.00). Payment shall be made to the State of Indiana, and will be due within thirty (30) days of the Commissioner's Final Order adopting this Agreed Entry.
- 6. Upon receipt of the five hundred dollars and 00/100 (\$500.00) civil penalty mentioned in paragraph 5, application 317894 will be accepted, and a non-resident producer's license will be issued to Applicant.
- 7. Applicant has carefully read this agreement and fully understands and accepts its terms.
- 8. Should this Agreed Entry not be accepted by the Commissioner, it is agreed that presentation to and consideration of this Agreed Entry by the

Commissioner shall not unfairly or illegally prejudice the Commissioner from further participation in or resolution of these proceedings.
