- 5. Applicant must complete an application for written consent to engage in the business of insurance pursuant to 18 U.S.C. §§ 1033 & 1034.

 Applicant must submit said application to the Department before the Commissioner will consider the adoption of this Agreed Entry.
- 6. The Department will give Applicant written consent to engage in the business of insurance pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 1033(e)(2) contemporaneous with the issuance of Applicant's resident producer's license.
- 7. Applicant will be placed on probation for a period of two (2) years.
- 8. Should this Agreed Entry not be accepted by the Commissioner, it is agreed that presentation to and consideration of this Agreed Entry by the Commissioner shall not unfairly or illegally prejudice the Commissioner from further participation in or resolution of these proceedings.
