AGREED ENTRY

This Agreed Entry is executed by and between the Indiana Department of Insurance ("Department"), by counsel, and Antolin J. Reiber ("Applicant") to resolve all matters in the above referenced cause number. This Agreed Entry is subject to the review and approval of Stephen W. Robertson, Commissioner of the Department.

WHEREAS, from February 22, 2000 to February 28, 2006, Applicant was a resident licensed producer, license number 385063;

WHEREAS, Applicant's license expired on February 28, 2006 after he failed to renew it; WHEREAS, Applicant is also a licensed Indiana attorney. However, his law license is currently suspended pursuant to a June 5, 2012 Order by Chief Justice Brent E. Dickson;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Judge Dickson's Order, Applicant's law license was suspended after he admitted to violating four (4) Rules of Professional Conduct – namely, RR. 1.16(d), 1.8(j), 1.16(a)(1), and 8.1(b), none of which pertain to acts of theft or *per se* dishonesty;

WHEREAS, on or about November 12, 2012, Applicant applied for a resident producer's license;

WHEREAS, on his application, Applicant disclosed Judge's Dickson's Order and that his law license is currently suspended pursuant to that Order;

WHEREAS, Judge Dickson's Order provided, in part, that Applicant failed to timely respond to inquiries made by the Supreme Court's Disciplinary Commission;

WHEREAS, the Department requires licensed producers to provide timely responses to its inquiries;

WHEREAS, Applicant's behavior, as alleged herein, is cause to deny his license application pursuant to Ind. Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(8); and

WHEREAS, the Department and Applicant desire to resolve their differences and settle the issues without a hearing.

IT IS, THEREFORE, NOW AGREED by and between the parties as follows:

- 1. The Commissioner has jurisdiction over the subject matter and parties in this administrative action.
- 2. This Agreed Entry is executed voluntarily by both parties.
- 3. Applicant voluntarily and freely waives his right to a public hearing.
- 4. Applicant voluntarily and freely waives his right to judicial review of this matter.
- 5. Applicant's application for a producer's license shall be granted.
- 6. Applicant shall be placed on probation for a period of two (2) years from the date his license is issued.
- 7. Applicant understands that any violation of Indiana's insurance laws, or failure to provide timely responses to inquiries made by the Department, shall be considered a violation of his probation and will result in the Department filing a Statement of Charges against him.

- 8. Applicant has carefully read this agreement and fully understands and accepts its terms.
- 9. Should this Agreed Entry not be accepted by the Commissioner, it is agreed that presentation to and consideration of this Agreed Entry by the Commissioner shall not unfairly or illegally prejudice the Commissioner from further participation in or resolution of these proceedings.
