**FINAL ORDER**

The Indiana Department of Insurance ("Department") and Bunger & Robertson ("Respondent"), a licensed Indiana insurance producer firm, signed an Agreed Entry which purports to resolve all issues involved in the action by the Department regarding Respondent's action and which has been submitted to the Commissioner of Insurance ("Commissioner") for approval.


The Commissioner, after reviewing the Agreed Entry, finds it has been entered into fairly and without fraud, duress or undue influence, and is fair and equitable between the parties. The Commissioner hereby incorporates the Agreed Entry as if fully set forth herein, and approves and adopts in full the Agreed Entry as a resolution of this matter.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, by the Commissioner of Insurance:

1. Respondent shall pay a civil penalty of two hundred and fifty (\$250.00) to the Indiana Department of Insurance and eight hundred and fifty six (\$856.00) to the Indiana Home

Ownership Education account within thirty (30) days of the signing of this Final Order for non-compliance with the Indiana insurance producer licensing statutes and the RREAL IN data base reporting statutes respectively.

**AGREED ENTRY**

This Agreed Entry is entered into by Dan L. Oliver, Attorney for and on behalf of the State of Indiana, Department of Insurance ("Department"), and Bunger & Robertson, ("Respondent"), a licensed resident insurance producer firm holding Indiana insurance license number 654586, to resolve all matters under Cause Number 11660-CO12-1220-022. This Agreed Entry is subject to the review and approval of Stephen W. Robertson, Commissioner of the Indiana Department of Insurance.

WHEREAS, Respondent is a licensed insurance producer firm in the State of Indiana;  
and

WHEREAS, during the course of an examination of Respondent, the examiner Fred Medley discovered that Respondent's Agency Producer License had expired from June 30, 2011 to October 5, 2011; and

WHEREAS, the agency failed to enter one hundred and seven (107) real estate transaction transactions onto the RREAL IN data base; and

WHEREAS, the agency benefited from the collection of premiums and closing fees which resulted from transactions examined by their examiners during the time the license had expired; and

WHEREAS, Thomas Bungler, Owner/Manager is authorized to act on behalf of the agency producer firm and obligates it to perform in accordance with this agreement; and

WHEREAS, the agency producer firm has since obtained the proper license and is currently practicing the business of selling, soliciting or negotiating title insurance in the State of Indiana and the agency producer firm has entered the previously omitted real estate transactions information onto the RREAL IN data base ; and

WHEREAS, the parties desire to resolve their differences and settle the issues without a hearing;

IT IS, THEREFORE, NOW AGREED by and between the parties as follows:


1. The Commissioner has jurisdiction over the subject matter and the Respondent in this administrative action.
2. This Agreed Entry is executed voluntarily by the parties.
3. Respondent voluntarily and freely waives its right to a public hearing on the issues in this action.
4. Respondent waives its right for a judicial review of this matter.
5. Respondent agrees to pay a civil penalty of two hundred and fifty dollars (\$250.00) to the Indiana Department of Insurance and eight hundred fifty six (\$856.00) to the Indiana Home Ownership Education Account within thirty days

(30) of the signing of the Commissioner's Final Order for non-compliance with the Indiana insurance producer licensing statutes.

6. Should this Agreed Entry not be accepted by the Commissioner, it is agreed that presentation to and consideration of this Agreed Entry by the Commissioner shall not unfairly or illegally prejudice the Commissioner from further participation in or resolution of these proceedings.

7. The Department agrees to accept Respondent's compliance with the terms of this Agreed Entry as full resolution of this matter.

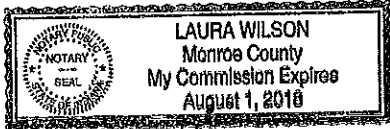
