MOTION TO REVOKE BAIL AGENT LICENSE

Comes now the Bail Bond Division ("Division"), by its counsel, Robert L. Hummel, and shows the Court as follows:

- 1. That on September 27, 2013, Respondent was found guilty of one (1) count of Disorderly Conduct, a Class B Misdemeanor, in Elkhart County (Indiana) Superior Court #1, Cause #20D01-1208-FD-981. See Exhibit "A" attached hereto.
 - 2. That on November 1, 2013, the Division obtained a certified copy of the court's order.
- 3. That Ind. Code §27-10-1-6 defines "disqualifying offense" to include "a misdemeanor if an element of the offense involves dishonesty, violence, or a deadly weapon."
- 4. That the Amended Information Charging Two (2) Counts filed in Elkhart Superior Court #1 on September 25, 2013 states under Count II, the Disorderly Conduct count, that Respondent "did recklessly engage in fighting or tumultuous conduct." See Exhibit "B" attached hereto.

5. That Respondent's Disorderly Conduct Class B Misdemeanor conviction was a

disqualifying offense since an element of the offense involved violence.

6. That Ind. Code §27-10-3-8(d) states: "The Commissioner shall revoke the license of

any person who is convicted of a disqualifying offense immediately upon conviction. The pending

of sentencing or the pending of an appeal of a conviction of a disqualifying offense does not stay the

revocation of a license under this subsection."

7. That Ind. Code §27-10-3-8(d) further states: "A person convicted of a misdemeanor

disqualifying offense is not eligible to reapply for a license until five (5) years from the date of

conviction or release from imprisonment, parole, or probation, whichever is later."

WHEREFORE, the Division, by its counsel, Robert L. Hummel, respectfully requests that the

Commissioner issue an order revoking Respondent's bail agent license per the terms of Ind. Code

§27-10-3-8(d).
