AGREED ENTRY

This Agreed Entry is entered into by Robert L. Hummel, attorney for and on behalf of the Indiana Department of Insurance ("Department"), and Knight-Barry Title Inc ("Respondent"), to resolve all matters regarding an investigation by the Department's Title Insurance Division. This Agreed Entry is subject to the review and approval of Stephen W. Robertson, Commissioner of the Indiana Department of Insurance.

WHEREAS, Respondent is a licensed non-resident insurance producer firm doing business in the State of Indiana; and

WHEREAS, during the course of an examination of Respondent, Senior Examiner Nicole Lotter discovered Respondent employed Elizabeth Peetz as a closing agent who is not a licensed insurance producer; and

WHEREAS, the agency benefited from the collection of premiums and closing fees resulting from transactions examined by the examiners; and

WHEREAS, Cheryl Hipenbecker, General Counsel, is authorized to act on behalf of the agency and obligate it to perform in accordance with this agreement; and

WHEREAS, the parties desire to resolve their differences and settle the issues without a hearing;

IT IS, THEREFORE, NOW AGREED by and between the parties as follows:

- 1. The Commissioner has jurisdiction over the subject matter and the Respondent in this administrative action.
- 2. This Agreed Entry is executed voluntarily by the parties.
- 3. Respondent voluntarily and freely waives its right to a public hearing on the issues in this action.
- 4. Respondent waives its right for a judicial review of this matter.
- 5. Respondent admits that it allowed an individual to sell, solicit, and negotiate title insurance without a valid producer license in violation of Indiana law.
- 6. Respondent agrees to pay a civil penalty of five hundred dollars (\$500.00) within thirty (30) days after the Commissioner signs the Final Order.
- 7. Should this Agreed Entry not be accepted by the Commissioner, it is agreed that presentation to and consideration of this Agreed Entry by the Commissioner shall not unfairly or illegally prejudice the Commissioner from further participation in or resolution of these proceedings.
- 8. The Department agrees to accept Respondent's compliance with the terms of this Agreed Entry as full resolution of this matter.
- 9. Respondent is aware that failure to comply with any of the terms of this agreement will result in the matter being set for a hearing and may result in the permanent revocation of its insurance license and/or an additional civil penalty.
