Cooper, ("Respondent"), a licensed Indiana bail bond agent, to resolve all issues concerning an investigation by the Division. This Agreed Entry is subject to the review and approval of Stephen W. Robertson, Commissioner, Indiana Department of Insurance.

WHEREAS, Respondent is a licensed bail bond agent, license number 5533; and WHEREAS, on January 29, 2014 the Indiana Department of Insurance received a complaint that the Respondent's business card was visible in the information window at the Allen County Jail and that Respondent displayed her business card in the jail lobby on a lanyard around her neck; and

WHEREAS, the Department and Respondent desire to resolve their differences and settle the issues without a hearing;

IT IS THEREFORE, NOW AGREED by and between the parties as follows:

1. The Commissioner has jurisdiction over the subject matter of and the parties to this Agreed Entry.

- 2. This Agreed Entry is executed voluntarily by the parties.
- 3. Respondent voluntarily and freely waives her right to a public hearing on the issues in this investigation.
- 4. Respondent admits that using her business cards to solicit bail business in the Allen County Jail was contrary to Indiana bail law.
- 5. Respondent agrees to payment of a civil penalty in the amount of two hundred dollars (\$200.00), payable by personal check or money order to the State of Indiana.
- 6. The Department agrees to accept Respondent's compliance with the terms of this agreement as full resolution of the issues.
- 7. Respondent voluntarily and freely waives her right to petition for judicial review of this agreement and the Commissioner's Final Order.
- 8. Respondent is aware that her failure to comply with any of the terms of this agreement will result in the matter being set for hearing and may result in the permanent revocation of her bail bond license and/or additional civil penalties.
- 9. Should this Agreed Entry not be accepted by the Commissioner, it is agreed that presentation to and consideration of this Agreed Entry by the Commissioner shall not unfairly or illegally prejudice the Commissioner from further participation in or resolution of these proceedings.
- Respondent has carefully read this agreement and fully understands and accepts its terms.

Purpose

The purpose of this memo is to request approval of the attached Agreed Entry.

Statement of the Issue

Soliciting bail bond business in the jail.

Facts

Angel Cooper is a licensed bail agent who resides in Fort Wayne. She has been licensed since June.2013. We received a complaint from another bail agent that Ms. Cooper had given her business card to a jail staff member and the card was displayed in the information window at the Allen County jail. Additionally, Ms. Cooper, while present in the jail, wore her business card around her neck on a lanyard.

<u>Analysis</u>

Soliciting bail business in or about a jail or courtroom is prohibited by IC 27-10-4-2(a)(6) and 760 IAC 1-6.2-2. Also see Bulletin 192. This is Ms. Cooper's first offense. She has been cooperative and realizes that she cannot display her business card in the jail or courthouse. She has agreed to pay a fine of \$200. Although the Agreed Entry does not set a date to pay the fine, she had agreed to pay it within 30 days and that requirement is included in the Final Order.

Recommendation

I recommend approval of the Agreed Entry.
