AGREED ENTRY

This Agreed Entry is executed by and between the Title Division of the Indiana Department of Insurance ("Department"), by counsel, Holly Williams, and First American Title ("Respondent"), to resolve all issues in the above-captioned matter. This Agreed Entry is subject to the review and approval of Stephen W. Robertson, Commissioner of the Indiana Department of Insurance ("Commissioner").

WHEREAS, Respondent is a resident title insurance agency licensed in the State of Indiana, holding license number 1299930; and

WHEREAS, the Respondent failed to enter real estate transactions into the RREAL IN data base in violation of Ind. Code § 27-7-3-15.5; and,

WHEREAS, the Department and Respondent (collectively, the "Parties") desire to resolve their differences and settle their issues without the necessity of a hearing;

IT IS, THEREFORE, NOW AGREED by and between the parties as follows:

- The Commissioner has jurisdiction over the subject matter and the Parties to this Agreed Entry.
- 2. This Agreed Entry is executed voluntarily by the parties.
- 3. Respondent voluntarily and freely waives the right to a public hearing on the issues in this matter.
- 4. Respondent voluntarily and freely waives the right to judicial review of this matter.
- 5. Respondent acknowledges Ind. Code § 27-7-3-15.5 requires it to record real estate transactions into the RREAL IN database through May 21, 2014.
- Respondent does not deny that real estate transactions were not entered into the RREAL IN database.
- 7. Respondent shall enter all real estate transactions into the RREAL IN database within thirty (30) days of this Agreed Entry.
- 8. Respondent shall pay an administrative fine in the amount of five thousand dollars (\$5,000.00) to the Department within thirty (30) days of the Commissioner's Final Order adopting this Agreed Entry.
- 9. The Department agrees to accept Respondent's compliance with the agreement as full satisfaction of this matter.
- 10. Respondent has carefully read and examined this agreement and fully understands its terms.

11. Respondent has entered into this agreement freely, and has not been subject to duress, threat or undue influence.

12. Should this Agreed Entry not be accepted by the Commissioner, it is agreed that presentation to and consideration of this Agreed Entry by the Commissioner shall not unfairly or illegally prejudice the Commissioner from further participation in or resolution of these proceedings.

13. Respondent is aware that failure to comply with any term of this agreement will result in the matter being set for hearing.
