

PRELIMINARY ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
AND NOTICE OF LICENSE DENIAL

The Indiana Department of Insurance, pursuant to the Indiana Administrative Act, Indiana Code § 4-21.5-1 et seq. and Indiana Code § 27-1-28-18, hereby gives notice to George H. Rode, III ("Applicant") of the following Administrative Order:

1. Applicant filed an application for a resident independent adjuster license with the Commissioner on May 15, 2014. Following a review of materials submitted by Applicant in support of his application, the Commissioner of the Indiana Department of Insurance, ("Commissioner"), being fully advised, now hereby notifies Applicant that he has not fully met the requirements of licensure as stated by Indiana Code § 27-1-28-18(b). Specifically, Applicant was convicted of Possession of Methamphetamine, a Class D Felony.


2. Indiana Code § 27-1-28-18(c) provides that:

[i]f the commissioner refuses an application for licensure or for the renewal of an existing license under this chapter; the commissioner shall notify the applicant or licensee in writing, advising of the reason for the refusal. The applicant or licensee may, not more than thirty (30) days after receiving the commissioner's

notice of refusal, make written demand upon the commissioner for a hearing to determine the reasonableness of the refusal. The hearing must be held under Indiana Code §4-21.5 not more than twenty (20) days after the commissioner receives the applicant's or licensee's written demand

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the Applicant's request for licensure is hereby
DENIED pursuant to Indiana Code §27-1-28-18(b)(6).
