**FINAL ORDER**



Collier, and Jason Lassic (“Respondent”), a licensed resident insurance producer, signed an Agreed Entry which purports to resolve all issues involved in the above-captioned cause number, and which has been submitted to the Commissioner of the Indiana Department of Insurance (the “Commissioner”) for approval.

The Commissioner, after reviewing the Agreed Entry, finds it has been entered into fairly and without fraud, duress or undue influence, and is fair and equitable between the parties. The Commissioner hereby incorporates the Agreed Entry, as if fully set forth herein, and approves and adopts in full the Agreed Entry as a resolution of this matter.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Commissioner of Insurance:

1. Respondent's Producer's license shall be placed on probationary status for a period of two (2) years, and Respondent shall pay an administrative fine of two hundred fifty dollars (\$250.00) within thirty (30) days after the signing of the Final Order, for his failure to timely report his criminal proceedings to the Department.
2. The Department agrees to accept this agreement as full resolution of this matter.

**AGREED ENTRY**

This Agreed Entry is executed by and between the Enforcement Division of the Indiana Department of Insurance ("Department"), by counsel, Brigitte R. Collier, and Jason Lassic ("Respondent"), to resolve all issues in the above-captioned cause number. This Agreed Entry is subject to the review and approval of the Department's Commissioner, Stephen W. Robertson ("Commissioner");

WHEREAS, the Respondent is a licensed resident insurance producer, holding license number 740050;

WHEREAS, the Respondent's license expired April 30, 2015;

WHEREAS, on October 1, 2014, the Respondent was charged with misdemeanor theft of a cell phone that he mistakenly thought belonged to him;

WHEREAS, on May 14, 2015, the Respondent was convicted of misdemeanor theft;

WHEREAS, Respondent returned the cell and paid restitution for the market value for a replacement cell phone.

WHEREAS, the Respondent failed to disclose his proceedings to the Department;

WHEREAS, the Respondent's actions are in violation of Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-17(b), which states not more than thirty (30) days after an initial pretrial hearing date, a producer shall report to the commissioner any criminal prosecution of the producer initiated in any jurisdiction;


WHEREAS, the Department and Respondent (collectively, the "Parties") desire to resolve this matter without the necessity of a hearing.

IT IS, THEREFORE, NOW AGREED by and between the parties as follows:


1. The Commissioner has jurisdiction over the subject matter and the Parties to this Agreed Entry.
2. This Agreed Entry is executed voluntarily by the Parties.
3. Respondent voluntarily and freely waives the right to a public hearing on the issues in this matter.
4. Respondent voluntarily and freely waives the right to judicial review of this matter.
5. Respondent's Producer license shall be placed on probationary status for a period of two (2) years.
6. Respondent shall pay an administrative fine of Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$250.00) within thirty (30) days after the Commissioner signs the Final Order adopting this Agreed Entry.
7. Should additional violations manifest, further administrative actions will be taken for the new violation.

8. The Department agrees to accept Respondent's compliance with this agreement as full satisfaction of this matter.
9. Respondent has carefully read and examined this agreement and fully understands and accepts its terms.
10. Respondent has entered into this agreement freely, and has not been subject to duress, threat or undue influence.
10. Should this Agreed Entry not be accepted by the Commissioner, it is agreed that presentation to and consideration of this Agreed Entry by the Commissioner shall not unfairly or illegally prejudice the Commissioner from further participation in or resolution of these proceedings.
11. Respondent is aware that failure to comply with any terms of this agreement will result in the matter being set for a hearing.

**ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER**  
**NOTICE OF NONRENEWAL OF LICENSE**

The Indiana Department of Insurance, pursuant to Indiana Code § 4-21.5-1 *et seq.*, and Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12, hereby gives notice to Jason Lassic, ("Respondent") of the following Administrative Order:

1. Respondent, a resident of Indiana, is a licensed insurance producer, holding license number 836291 since February of 2011 ("Respondent's license").

2. Respondent's license expired on April 30, 2015.

3. On or about March 16, 2015 the Enforcement Division was notified by anonymous complaint that Respondent had been charged with misdemeanor theft on October 13, 2014.

4. The Department has learned that Respondent was convicted of misdemeanor theft on May 14, 2015.

5. Respondent did not disclose his criminal proceedings to the Department.

6. Pursuant to Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-17(b), not more than thirty (30) days after an initial pretrial hearing date, a producer shall report to the commissioner any criminal prosecution of the producer initiated in any jurisdiction.

7. Pursuant to Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(2)(A), the Commissioner may refuse to issue or renew an insurance producer's license for violating an insurance law.


8. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(d) requires the Commissioner to notify a licensee of the reason for the nonrenewal of his license. This Order serves as that notice.

9. The Commissioner further notifies Respondent that, pursuant to Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(d), Respondent may, within sixty three (63) days of receiving this Order, make a written demand upon the Commissioner for a hearing to determine the reasonableness of this action. Such a hearing shall be held within thirty (30) days from the date of receipt of Respondent's written demand.

WHEREFORE, based on the foregoing, the Commissioner of Insurance hereby notifies Respondent that **his license shall not be renewed.**
