PRELIMINARY ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER AND NOTICE OF LICENSE DENIAL

The Indiana Department of Insurance, pursuant to the Indiana Administrative Act, Indiana Code §4-21.5-1 *et seq.* and Indiana Code §27-19-4-5, hereby gives notice to Richard W. Sampson ("Applicant") of the following Administrative Order:

- Applicant filed an application for certification with the Commissioner of the Indiana
 Department of Insurance ("Commissioner") on May 21, 2015.
- 2. Before approving an application, the Commissioner must find that the applicant has met specific requirements under Indiana Code §27-19-4-5 and Indiana Code §27-19-4-3.
- 3. Indiana Code §27-19-4-3(a) provides, in part, that the Commissioner may refuse to issue or renew a navigator certification for having been convicted of a felony or other crimes determined by the Commissioner.
- 4. Following a review of materials submitted by Applicant in support of his application, the Commissioner being fully advised, now hereby notifies Applicant that he has not fully met the requirements of licensure as stated by Indiana Code §27-19-4-5 due to his August

08, 2002 conviction of Burglary, a Class C Felony, and his December 11, 2007 conviction of Theft, a Class A Misdemeanor.

5. Should Applicant wish for the Commissioner to review this decision, Applicant must, within fifteen (15) days after receiving notice of this Order, file a written petition with the Commissioner. This petition must state facts demonstrating that Applicant:

(A) is a person to whom this order is specifically directed;

(B) is aggrieved or adversely affected by this order; or

(C) is entitled to review under any law

If a petition for review is granted, the Department shall assign the matter to an administrative law judge to conduct informal proceedings to settle the matter.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the Applicant's request for certification is hereby DENIED pursuant to Indiana Code §27-19-4-5.
